Guidelines for Exit after One Year in PG Courses under NEP 2020

Under the provisions of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 and the National Credit Framework (NCrF), students enrolled in a two-year Postgraduate (PG) programme at Rajiv Gandhi University may exercise the Exit Option after the successful completion of the first year (NCrF Level 6.0). On opting for this provision, students will be awarded a Postgraduate Diploma in the concerned subject, in accordance with the University regulations.

(a) Eligibility for Exit

- Students enrolled in a 2-year Postgraduate (PG) programme may exit after successful completion of the first year (two semesters).
- The student must have earned all credits prescribed for the first year.
- Exit will be permissible only in compliance with the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 (enabled courses) or University-specific regulations.

(b) Award on Exit

- Students exiting after one year will be awarded a Postgraduate Diploma in [Subject] (or equivalent nomenclature as per university ordinance).
- The certificate shall indicate the courses completed and credits earned.

(c) Procedure for Exit

- The student must submit an Application “Application Form for Exit after One Year in PG Course” for Exit through the Head of the Department (HoD) to the Controller of Examinations of Rajiv Gandhi University.

(d) Clearance from the following sections is mandatory:

Before the Exit application can be processed, the student must obtain a **No Dues/ Clearance Certificate** from the following sections of the University:

- Department
- Library
- Hostel (if applicable)
- Accounts Section (fees and dues)

(e) Documentation Required:

- Exit Application Form (duly filled and signed)
- Copy of APAAR ID CARD
- Original ID Card
- Copy of 1st Semester and Second Semester Marksheet
- No Dues/ Clearance Certificates

(f) Readmission to PG Courses:

- Once the Exit option is exercised and certificate awarded, **re-admission into the same PG programme in the same academic session will not be permitted.**
- If a student desires to continue studies at a later stage, he/she shall be required to surrender the Postgraduate Diploma to the University. Fresh admission will then have to be sought as per the prevailing rules and regulations of Rajiv Gandhi University.
