

**MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF SUB-COMMITTEE OF NEP 2020
IMPLEMENTATION- AGENDA III**

A meeting of the sub-committee of NEP 2020 implementation- agenda iii, was held on 22/02/2023 at 03:00 p.m. in the Department of Management. The following members were present in the meeting.

At the outset, the members were welcomed by Mr. Arindam Chakrabarty and he appraised the importance of the meeting in the context of NEP 2020 implementation. The meeting unanimously recommended the following steps to way forward the prescribed agenda towards smooth implementation in the University and its affiliated colleges.

1. The members appreciated that NEP 2020 strongly adopted multi-disciplinary courses that should be incorporated in the curriculum of each programme in order to improve the employability of the learners after completing the respective programme/year of study. This would also enable the students who would be availing single/multiple exit due to financial or family reasons to maintain their livelihood which is consonance with fulfilling sustainable development goals (poverty, hunger by 2030).
2. In this context, the members opined that multi-disciplinary courses need to be identified for each programme or faculty as per the feasibility and demand of local market. The University would prepare an indicative list of skill enhancement courses along with identifying appropriate nodal knowledge bodies primarily from nearest regions. The final list of the courses would be prepared by the relevant department/faculty in a mutually convenient manner. Based on the recommendation from the University the affiliated college would take the initiative to execute the MOU with the appropriate and concerned knowledge body. An indicative list of multi-disciplinary courses has been mentioned faculty/department wise for ready reference along with concerned nodal knowledge body.
