EC:24:05: Constitution of a Roster Committee

The EC noted that the matter was discussed in the 23rd Meeting of the Academic Council held on 14th March, 2019, wherein, the Chairman apprised the members that the University is going to float advertisement for 17 vacant teaching positions sanctioned by the UGC for which a Roster Committee will be constituted soon.

The University is also going to float advertisement for 47 teaching positions sanctioned by UGC including the positions of Dept. of Security Studies.

The EC after thorough deliberation on the matter decided that the aforementioned sanctioned teaching positions will be governed by the Roster System on the basis of MHRD Roster points. The EC felt that for vacant positions already sanctioned earlier shall be governed by old roster and new positions shall be governed by new roster.

EC:24:06: On the introduction of Leave Pass Book in RGU

The EC noted that in the 23rd Meeting of the Academic Council held on 14 March, 2019, wherein, it was decided that Leave Passport format shall be issued to all the HoDs for recording and maintaining leave records of regular faculty members of the University.
