LANGUAGE AND CULTURAL FIELD DOCUMENTATION OF THE KASIK SPEECH

COMMUNITY: The second field trip of CFEL was carried out in Noksa village of Tirap District in order to document the language and culture of Kasik Noctes. The Kasik language falls among the endangered languages of Arunachal Pradesh and is spoken only in Noksa, Pullong and Tupi villages of Tirap District.

The total number of photographs taken during the trip is more than two thousand (2,000) and 3.7 hours of video recordings and 6.9 hours of audio recordings. The documentation consists of linguistic data, folk narratives, material culture, land and the people, festival, performances, etc.
