Field Documentation of the *Lha-Chuth* Festival

A week long fieldwork during February 2018 was carried out by the centre for endangered languages, AITS in Walong district to interact with the Meyor tribe about their language and culture. During this trip an extensive audio-visual documentation of the pre-agricultural festival of the Meyor tribe which is called *Lha-Chuth* was carryout. Around 500 photographs, 5 hours of video and 2 hours of Audio recordings were collected during the course of fieldwork.
