About

Rajiv Gandhi University (formerly Arunachal University) is the premier institution for higher education in the state of Arunachal Pradesh and has completed thirty five years of its existence. Late Smt. Indira Gandhi, the then Prime Minister of India, laid the foundation stone of the university on 4th February 1984 at Rono Hills, where the present campus is located. Ever since its inception, the university has been trying to achieve excellence and fulfill the objectives as envisaged in the University Act.

The University is located atop Rono Hills on a picturesque tableland of 302 acres overlooking the river Dikrong. It is 6.5 km away from the National Highway 52-A and 25 km away from Itanagar, the State capital. The campus is linked with the National Highway by a Dikrong bridge. The teaching and research programmes of the University are designed with a view to play a positive role in the socio-economic and cultural development of the State. The University has been extending educational facilities to the students from the neighbouring States, particularly Assam. The strength of students in different Departments of University and in affiliated colleges has been steadily increasing.

Rajiv Gandhi University with its motto "Vidhyaamritshnute" i.e. "Excellence and Immortality through nectar of Education"

has been striving to maintain high standards in both teaching and research. Years of concerted efforts have shown the signs of qualitative and quantitative progress. PLACEMENT CELL

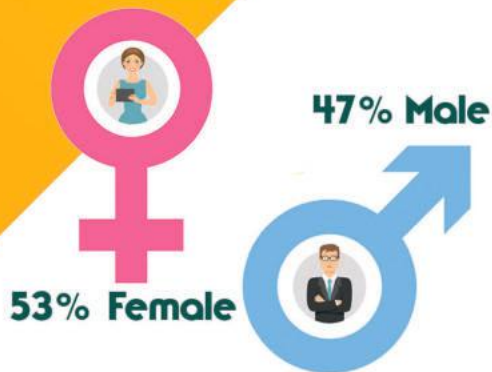
ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- ★ 1. Rajiv Gandhi Univeristy Common Entrance Test (RGUCET) is an entrance test for admission into the Post Graduate, Under Graduate Programmes and Professional Degree Courses.
- ★ 2. Applicants for M.Tech courses with valid GATE score and above a prescribed cut-off score are exempted from the RGUCET.
- ★ 3. The syllabus for each PG programme will be the pass course syllabus of the corresponding UG programme offered by RGU. For M.Tech the syllabus will be identical to the GATE syllabus of preceding year.
- ★ 4. RGUCET question paper contains 100 Multiple Choice Question (MCQs) and will usually contain many sections:
 - i).25 MCQs that examine language ability, reasoning, general awareness, mathematical aptitude/data interpretation and analytical skills expected of a University level candidate.
 - ii).75 MCQs that examine domain knowledge of a given course.
 - iii).For interdisciplinary courses M.A (anthropology / Education / Mass Communication / sociology), M.Ed, MBA, MCA and MSW, all 100 MCQs will examine language ability, reasoning, general awareness, Mathematical aptitude/data in interpretation and analytical skills.
 - iv).The candidate will have to choose on correct answer. 1 mark will be awarded for every correct answer.
 - v).Negative Marking: 0.25 marks will be deducted for every wrong answer.
 - vi).Duration: The written examination will be of two hours duration.
- ★ 5. Group Discussion/Viva Voce
For MBA, M.A in Mass Communication and MSW courses only, the candidates who qualified in the written test will be called for group discussion and/or viva voce. The group discussion and/or viva-voce component will be of 25 marks. The cumulative marks obtained from written test, group discussion and/or viva voce will be used to finalize the selected candidates.

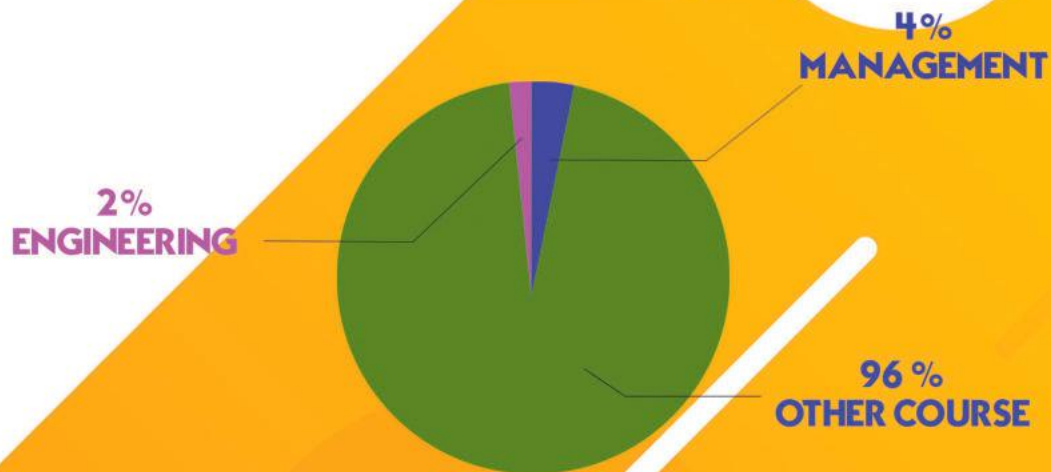

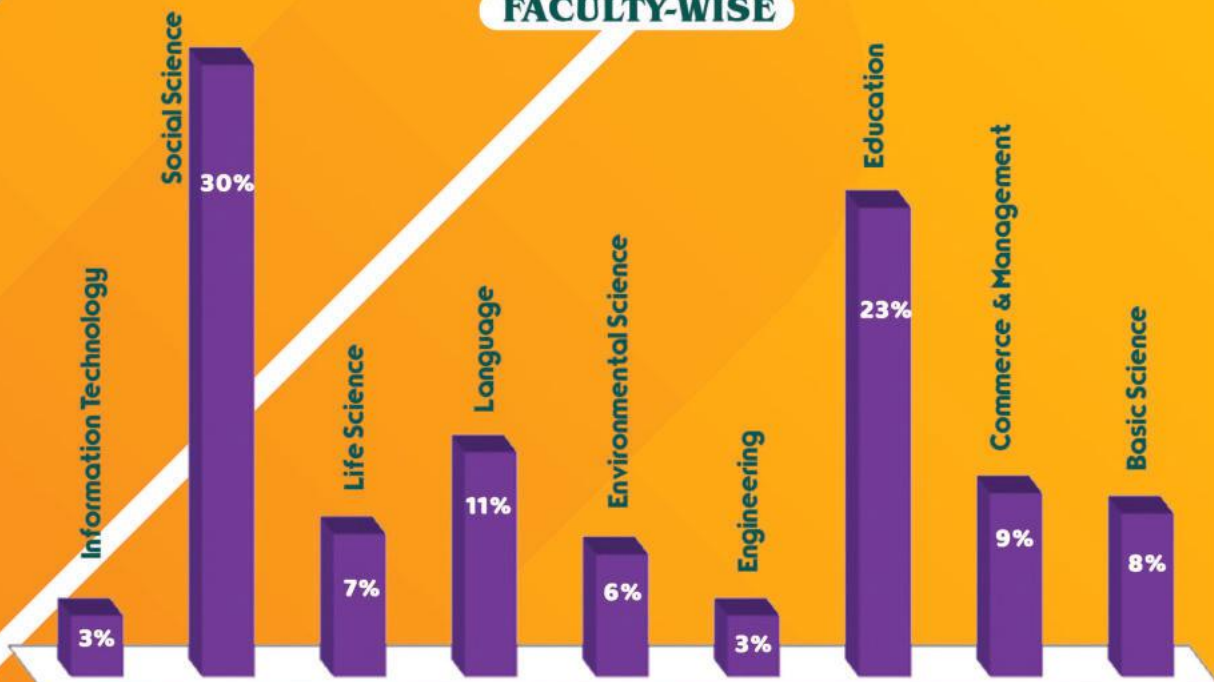

1 Chemistry

The Department of Chemistry was established in the year 2011 under the stewardship of Prof. Kamalesh Choudhury, a noted academician and educator from Assam. It marked a humble beginning to impart quality teaching and research in chemistry in this remote region of India. The department offers two-year (4 semesters) M.Sc. CBCS programme to provide students with the necessary theoretical background and introduction to laboratory methods. The scheme of instruction consists of lectures, tutorials, laboratory work, seminars and project work. In addition to this, the department offers Ph.D. programme in chemistry.

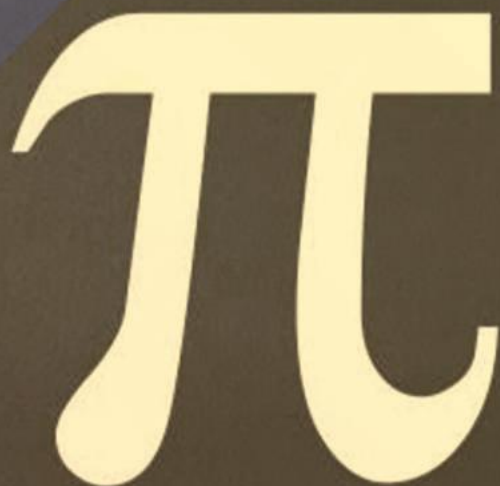

2 Mathematics

The founder Head (HoD) of Department of Mathematics was Dr. Tarekeswar Choudhury(Retd.), Cotton College, Assam. The department of Mathematics is an important constituent of the Faculty of Basic Sciences since 2005, the year when it was established. The department offers two-years (Four Semesters) M. A./M. Sc. programme in Mathematics & Computing and total intake capacity of P. G. programme is 40 (Forty). In addition, we offer M. Phil. (Four Semesters) programme with seat capacity Five since 2015. Apart from these, the department of Mathematics has started Ph. D. programme from 2013 in Mathematics & Computing with seven scholars in different research domains of Pure and Applied Mathematics. Our faculty members specialize in various areas of Algebra, Analysis and Applied Mathematics. The department aims to train people who are oriented towards research and teaching in advanced areas of Pure and Applied Mathematics. The objectives of the department are to impart quality education to those seeking admission to M. Sc., M. Phil. and Ph. D. programmes, promote theoretical and applied research, publish original works and develop interaction with other departments of the university, R&D establishments, industries and other organizations.

3 Physics

The department of Physics was started in the year 2011 under the guidance of then Visiting Professor and Head (i/c) Prof. (Late) Hiralal Das, Retired Professor, Gauhati University with one laboratory (temporary) staff with ten students. As the department was flagging at that time, in 2012, 2 (two) regular Assistant Professors and four permanent laboratory staffs were induced. Now, at this instant, the department is added with 2 (two) Professors with intake capacity of 29 (twenty-nine), as well as 14 (fourteen) Research Scholars. From the start of the department, Guest Assistant Professor and Visiting Professors are regularly appointed as per the requirements.

The Department of Education was established in 1988 by recruiting one Professor, two Readers and four Lecturers. The Department launched the B.Ed programme in the academic session 1988-89 as it was desired by the Government of Arunachal Pradesh for clearing the backlog of untrained teachers working in secondary and senior secondary schools. The Department was also set up with the objective of producing the faculty for teaching at college and University level. M.A. (Education) two year course was needed at the college level to teach the students of B.A. (Hons) of Education. M.Ed programme was started in 2014 as per the UGC XII plan allocation order of MHRD, Government of India. At present, the Department is running B.Ed programme with intake capacity of 100 students, M.Ed Programme with the intake of 26 students and M.A (Education) with the intake of 45 students.

2 Geology

The Department of Geology has started its journey in 2017 with recruitment of two Assistant Professors and enrolment of 18 (eighteen) students to B.Sc. (Hons.) course from the session 2017-18 with Prof. Nishamani Kar, Dean of the Faculty of Environmental Sciences as its Co-ordinator. Being located in the foothills of eastern part of the Himalaya, the department has a brighter vision to engage the students in academic and research activities to better understand various aspects of geology of the eastern Himalaya and of the NE India. Arunachal Pradesh is the largest state in NE India with availability of natural laboratory for geoscientists in the form of rock exposures to unravel the surface and subsurface geological processes. Large part of the state is still geologically unexplored while the state has a large potential for natural resources in term of mineral wealth, coal, hydrocarbon etc. besides huge potential for hydropower. Since the state lacks any institution offering higher education in Geosciences, even at undergraduate level, this department was established in Rajiv Gandhi University. Initially the department has started offering three year undergraduate course (B.Sc.) with honours in Geology but subsequently postgraduate and research courses will also be introduced in due course

of time. The curriculum for the undergraduate course is designed in such a way to lay strong foundation in theoretical, practical and field knowledge for the students. Besides, the department is also committed to play a pivotal role for high quality research in different geo-scientific aspects of Eastern Himalaya.

The department aims to excel in teaching and research in geosciences, especially to better understand geology of northeastern India and Arunachal Himalaya. 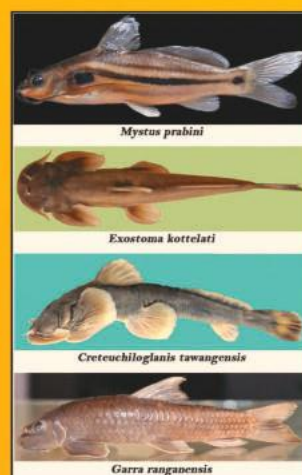

3 Economics

The Department of Economics made its beginning in July 1991. The final report was released in October 2006. The Centre for Development Studies (CDS) was set up in 2013 with a generous grant of the corpus fund of Rs 10 crore from Ministry of Finance, Government of India as a research adjunct at the Department of Economics, Rajiv Gandhi University to provide better research facilities to the faculty, research scholars as well as the students of the Department of Economics. 1. Bank A branch of Bank of Baroda with ATM facility operates in the Administrative Block to meet the banking needs of the students and rest of the University community. One SBI ATM booth is also installed in the campus.

2. Post Office An EDBPO (Sub-Post office), with speed post facility also functions in the university campus as well.

3. Canteen & Co-Operative Store A central canteen, a tea stall, a cafeteria, a Co-operative store, a Book stall, a Pharmacy, few stationery-cum-grocery shops, a laundry and a salon in a shopping complex cater to the general needs of the University community. Xeroxing facility is also available in the campus.

4. Computer Centre Established in 2004, the Computer centre of the University has been successfully fulfilling its objectives. Presently, Computer Centre is housed at University Library and the Academic Block. The centre has a Help Desk, namely, "Computer Maintenance Facility", to facilitate troubleshooting of problems brought in by the members of the university community in connection with IT and computers.

5. EDUSAT Centre It was Establishment in the year 2005 which was sponsored by UGC-CEC. Regular classes taught through multicast by CEC for various subjects especially on Development Studies, Mass media, Career counseling, Hindi, Health, Environment Studies, Economics, Information communication technology, Sociology, public relation, education, Political Science & Geography were received at the EDUSAT and routed to Campus LAN. Some important lectures were recorded as archival material in the EDUSAT Server. The programme is also simultaneously telecast through DTH (Dish TV Channel 772). Teaching end has been upgraded with better media capability and TrainNet Software for two way interaction with the resource person.

6. Health Centre A four bedded Health Center is operational with two experienced medical officers, three nurses, technicians and a pharmacist. Soon it shall be upgraded to a 14-bedded one with modern medical equipments and facilities. 24 hours Ambulance facility for any emergency is available round the clock.

7. Central Library The total number of books as on today is 63576 out of which approx. 3000 books are reference nature and approx. 2000 gifted books. The University Library subscribes 14 local, regional and national dailies & 15 numbers of magazines. University Library also subscribes 15 International Journals and 75 National Print Journals. The University Library is registered/ enrolled as an Institutional Member of Developing Library Network (DELNET), New Delhi, which is a major Digital Library Resource in South Asia.

8. Digital Library There is a separate cell to facilitate for internet browsing for the students, research scholars and faculties. They can browse and access more than 9000 plus E- Journals full text online under Sodh Sindhu Library consortium and Developing Library Network (DELNET) the major Digital Library Resource in South Asia extended to the readers. (OPAC) online public access catalogue facility can be accessed by IP:10.1.0.201. There is separate section for Text-Books, current Periodicals, dissertations (195 nos.) and Thesis (244 nos.) are on display, as well on database. The circulation through Kiosk from Smart Card RFID system is functional. ETD (Electronic Thesis & Dissertation) and Digitized rare books on Arunachal and E-Books are also available.

9. Transport Facilities The University extends adequate bus services from the Campus to Nirjuli, Naharlagun & Itanagar for students and staff at concessional rates. Frequent bus services are provided to NERIST point in Nirjuli on National Highway 52-A, from where public transport facility can be easily availed.

10. Hostel Accommodation The University maintains 10(Ten) hall of residence for students (5 for Men & 5 for Women) with accommodation capacity of 1024 residents with facilities like common room, TV and Indoor Games. Accommodation in separate hall of residence for B.Ed/M.Ed, regular M.Phil and Ph.D scholars are provided on merit.

11. Career Counseling Cell The Career Counseling Cell (CCC) started on 21st August 2012 with an objective to set up an educational counseling services offered for the post-graduate students of Rajiv Gandhi University with the aim to help the students redefine their passion in their career, develop essential employability skills and strategies and to understand different competitive examination related to job opportunities in current market scenario. Career Counseling Cell has organized 9 Skill-based training programme under the expert professionals and resource persons invited from the state as well as national level.

12. International Scholars' Cell This cell has been established to meet the interest of foreign students and scholars to carry out studies and research activities in the university.

13. NET Coaching Centre The centre was first established as a Pre-Examination Training Centre (PETC) in the year 1996 to impart coaching to the SC/ST/OBC (Creamy Layer) Female (General) Minority students for preparing themselves to appear UGC/ CSIR NET Examinations as well as University Examinations with the active participation of subject coordinators from different departments with an Honorary Director to run the affairs of the centre.

14. University Industry Interface Cell Established in the Year 2014, this cell is first of its kind in the entire North East, and is functional from the Department of Management. The cell is playing its part in bringing industries closer to the University Students. Entrepreneurship has been recognized throughout the world as one the engines of growth and development. Although, there are exceptional success stories within the region, the aggregate entrepreneurial activity is subdued in comparison with rest of the country.

15. The Centre for Entrepreneurship Rajiv Gandhi University was set up in May, 2015. The objectives of the cell to build entrepreneurship capacity building in the state of Arunachal Pradesh. To develop an ecosystem for startups and SMEs. To run practical oriented courses in the centre especially for students.

16. RO Water Facility The RO treated water is available for the students and other stakeholders of the university which is located near the Guest House.

17. LAN Wi Fi Facility Internet access facility which is an essential service to the university is being monitored and maintained properly. Campus-wide Local Area Network (LAN) of the university which is the core infrastructure in enabling sharing of resources and flow of information within and outside the University has been constantly expanding as the main facilitator of all the IT enabled services. VSAT Facility also provides internet connectivity through a 2mbps leased line link and 1 mbps DAMA VSAT link from ERNET India, New Delhi. 1 gbps connectivity under NKN has already been extended to the university by National Informatics Centre (NIC), Itanagar using the leased line circuit from BSNL. Recently, high speed internet wi-fi connectivity has been installed in the entire campus. Creating wireless hotspots, application repository and various other intranet services are now available.

18. Extra Curricular and Co Curricular Facilities The University extends facilities for extra-curricular and co-curricular activities to the students. Apart from the auditorium with indoor badminton court, there are tennis, caroms, etc. The University also participates in Inter-University games and sports competitions. 19. E-waste management E-waste (Electronic waste) comprises of obsolete computers, mobile, i-pod, televisions, etc which is ready for the disposal from the original user. These wastes become life threatening element and impact the environment. Hence, Rajiv Gandhi University provides awareness to the students about proper disposal and management of such e-waste in the campus. The students are taught about the process of easy recycling of day to day electronic waste. Thus, the University allows students to learn effective usage, dumping and recycling of the electronic waste on the natural environment. Hence, the university contributes towards sustainable development in the university campus through this e-waste management system.

20. Solid waste management This innovative project has been introduced in the RGU by Prof. S. Kushwaha, Vice Chancellor. Currently, the solid waste management is under Women Technology Park. At present, paper recycling unit is functioning in the campus as the majority of waste is paper and the most viable mode of managing the waste is a paper recycling unit. The WTP is offering courses on handmade-paper making through the Institute of Distance Education and to create a market for eco-friendly stationary.

21. Organic waste management Rajiv Gandhi University started awareness campaign to the students about the impact of household food waste and shared the ways to prevent food waste at hostel, home or in canteens/cafeterias. In this way the University brings students together to take a pledge to save food and value the food served on plate. The Organic waste management has started to prevent and reduce food waste in the campus. The Waste Management Team teaches the students to share the information to family members, friends, colleagues and others when they go out from the university.

22. Rain Water Harvesting RGU has started to harvest rainwater from the roofs of IDE and Geography department buildings. The students of Institute of Distance Education, Mathematics and Geography departments are being benefitted currently. The university administration has decided to install rainwater harvesting system in the selected buildings to meet the water requirement of the campus.

23. Grievances Cell The University is monitoring and addressing the various grievances of different stakeholders including students through its robust public grievances cell. The university grievance cell is working under the Centralized Public Grievance Redress and Monitoring System, which is an online web-enabled system over NICNET developed by NIC in association with the Department of Administrative Reforms and Public Grievances (DARPG) with an objective of speedy redress and effective monitoring of grievances by Ministries/ Departments/ Organizations of Government of India.

24. Sexual Harassment Cell RGU is having full-fledged sexual harassment cell which gives orientation to the students from time to time about consequences of sexual harassment as well as empowering them to report if such things happen. The cell has a help line number in which one can register their complaint. The cell conducts awareness programme on the implication of a demand for sexual favours, eve-teasing or any other unwelcome conduct of sexual harassment nature.

25. Facilities for differently able Differently-able persons need special arrangements in the environment for their mobility and independent functioning. Rajiv Gandhi University ensures that all existing structures as well as future construction projects in the campuses are made disabled friendly. To suit the special needs of differently-able persons, RGU has created special facilities such as ramps, rails and special toilets and made other necessary changes to address the accessibility issues pertaining to disability.

26. Security Cell Rajiv Gandhi University has a full-fledged security cell which works day and night for safety and security of all denizens of the campus. Security cell is headed by senior security officer and his team of security guards. The guards are in the entrance gate as well as in the entire department to check any untoward incidences in the university campus. The CCTV cameras are also being monitored by the security cell, RGU.

27. Women Technology Park Established in 2001 under the UGC Xth Plan, the park provides training facilities to the unemployed young women residing in the peripheral of the university campus in mushroom cultivation, weaving, cultivation of local and rare organic vegetables, etc. The park supply seasonal organic vegetables to the campus dwellers.

28. RGU Atal Community Innovation Centre RGUACIC For different activities and research projects RGU set-up Atal Community Innovation Centre (ACIC) as the university has been guided by Atal Innovation Mission (AIM) of NITI Aayog, New Delhi. The University has undertaken collaborative research projects under the aegis of Indian Central Himalayan Universities Consortium-an initiative of NITI Aayog. The University is also initiated a social science research project on rural and boarder areas of Arunachal Pradesh under RGUACIC.





4. University Guest House, RGU, Rono Hills

1. Invitations are sent to companies through email along with response sheets enquiring about the recruitment details. A soft copy of placement brochure is also sent with the mail.
 2. The company fills the response sheet and sends it by e-mail to the placement cell, RGU. The job Announcement is being sent by the company to placement cell.
 3. Once the details about the vacancies are received, mutually a convenient date is fixed for campus recruitment.
 4. Once date is fixed, the announcement letter of campus recruitment is circulated to the students through mail, by broadcasting on RGU website & notice sent to the departments to display on the notice board.
 5. Thereafter, the travel plans are obtained from the company. The accommodations and necessary logistic support are given for the recruitment process.
 6. Subsequently, the candidates are shortlisted for the placement drive.
 7. Recruitment process starts with written test / group discussion / presentation / interview, etc.
 8. The offers are made by the company to the successful candidates for appointment.
 9. The students may accept the offer letter and sign it and sent it to the company through placement cell, RGU.
 10. Placement cell ensures that the selected student reaches to the organization on specified date.

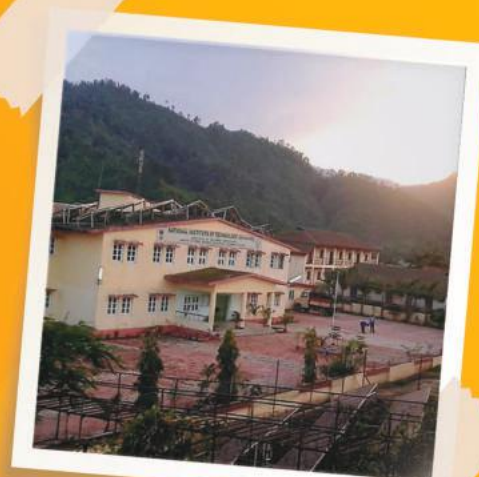
1. NERIST, Nirjuli

North Eastern Regional Institute of Science and Technology (or NERIST) is a science and technology oriented higher education institute in Nirjuli, Itanagar, in the Indian state of Arunachal Pradesh. Established in 1984, it is a deemed-to-be-university, autonomous, fully funded and controlled by the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India. The institute is managed by a Board of Management, comprising representatives of MHRD, the eight beneficiary states of the North Eastern region, AICTE and educationists. 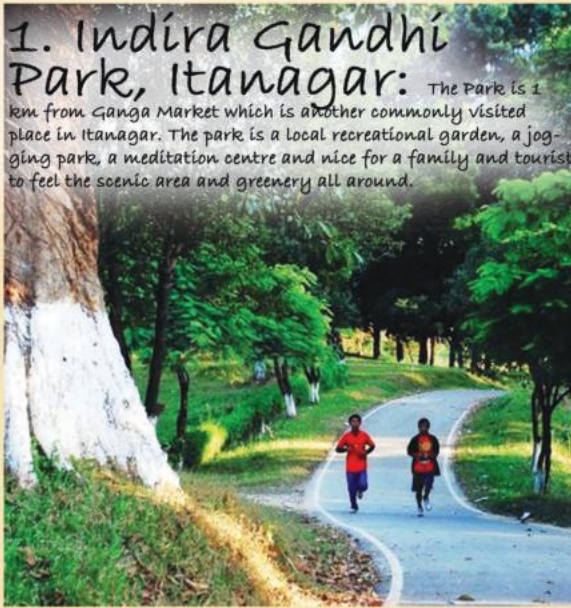

Major Tourist Attractions

1. Indira Gandhi Park, Itanagar:

The Park is 1 km from Ganga Market which is another commonly visited place in Itanagar. The park is a local recreational garden, a jogging park, a meditation centre and nice for a family and tourist to feel the scenic area and greenery all around.



2. Ita Fort:

The place is 2 km from Ganga Market which is yet another important place to visit in Itanagar. The name literally means "Fort of bricks" (brick being called "ita" in the Assamese language). The fort has an irregular shape, built mainly with bricks dating back to the 14th-15th Century. The total brickwork is of 16,200 cubic meter lengths which were built by kings of the Chutiya kingdom which ruled the region during that time. The fort has three different entrances at three different sides, i.e., the western, the eastern and the southern sides.



3. Ganga Lake:

It is also known as the Gyankear Singi, 6 km from Ganga Market, Itanagar which is a must visit places in Itanagar. Ganga Lake is a major tourist attraction and it is one of the most visited and popular attraction in Itanagar. Tourists from across the world visit this destination for recreational activities and it hosts a perfect place for dry picnic. Since the Lake is still, one can notice its colour to be green.

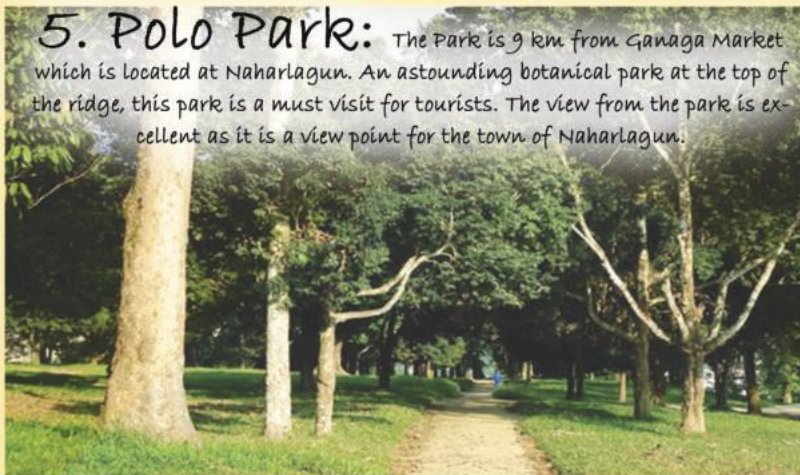


4. Gompa:

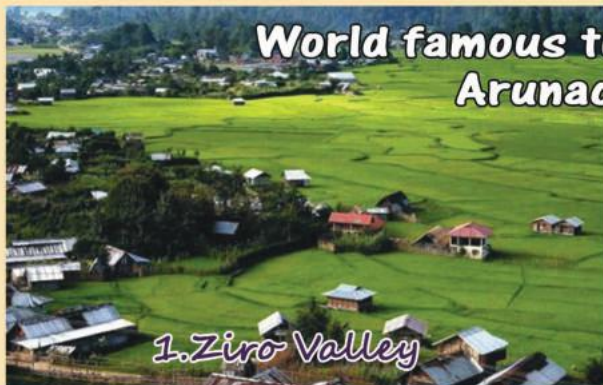
7. State Zoo:

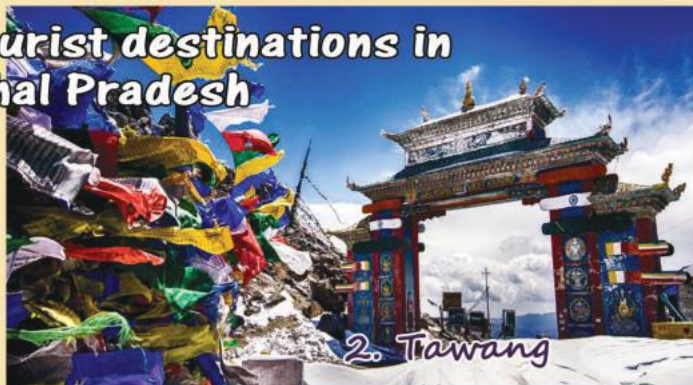

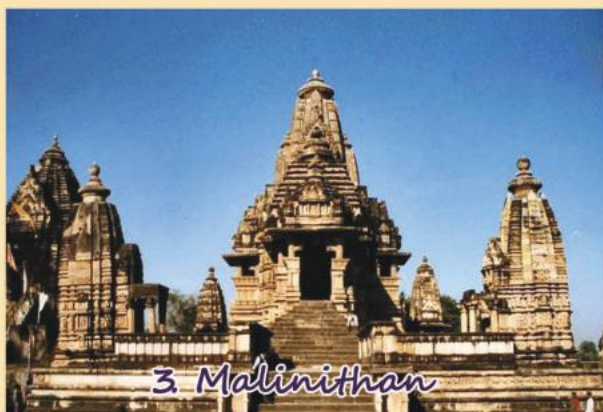

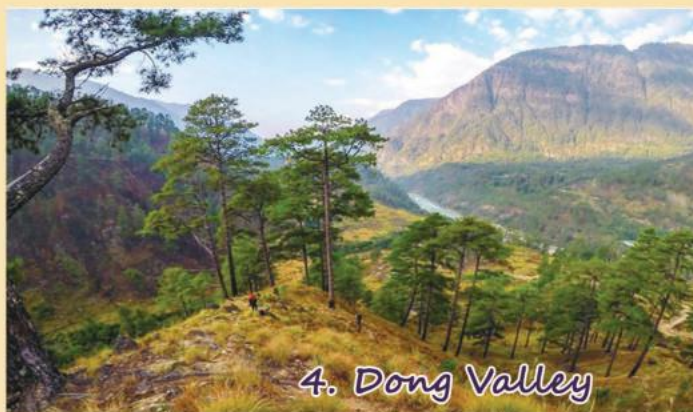
