2.2. LaTeX is a typesetting software for preparing reports, letters and presentations - especially useful for persons engaged in writing/ publishing documents from science/ arts/ commerce fields. LaTeX allows to manage references, figures, tables, footnotes, formatting, mathematical equations, algorithms, scientific proofs, and more in a programmatic fashion that provides benefits far exceeding that of word processing software.

2.3. Xfig is a free and open source vector graphics editor. Figures can be drawn using objects such as circles, boxes, lines, spline curves, text etc. In it, it is possible to import and work on images of all formats
