Rajiv Gandhi University, Central Library is information hub to its users. It is one of the smart Libraries among the North Eastern Central Universities. The Central Library has completed 34 years of existence. The library is rich in collection of books includes reference and general nature, all text books of various departments and disciplines. In recent collection, it has more than 12000 plus e-Books, 432 electronic theses available in Shodhganga and 542 Dissertations. The faculty members , researchers and students can access more than 10,000 plus e-journals full text. Besides, there are many more online databases like Delnet, Delcon, IEEE CSDL, EPWRF, EBSCO EDS are accessible to its users. One can access the availability of books and resources through web OPAC. At present, the library is well equipped with RFID (Radio Frequency Identification) enabled with electronic touch screen self-check-in and check-out kiosk. In addition, it also possesses more than 924 rare book collections from BITS Pilani. All the authorised members can able to access all its digital collection through e-platform i.e. Digital Library or Institutional Repository (IR) remotely. University Library also organizes user awareness programme from time to time in offline and online mode.

The exponential change in the preservation and conservation of knowledge is getting a new culture in 21st century. Gone are the days when locus of control of knowledge was available in the physio centric stage (smriti). But due to the emergence of new ICT and disruptive technologies the locus of knowledge has transformed from physio centric to scriptocentric and now available in the sky i.e. called digicentric. Rajiv Gandhi University has taken a step to digitalize its knowledge in the form of IR. The IR will preserve the knowledge and it cannot be destroyed as it was destroyed in the Nalanda University during ancient time.
