NOTIFICATION

The Rajiv Gandhi University notifies the following guidelines for Selection Procedure which is in force in connection with RGU Common Entrance Test-2021 [RGUCET-2021] under which the Common Entrance Test shall be conducted to admit candidates to various courses as notified on 16th July, 2021;

- (a) That, for admission into any post-graduate courses/programs and Professional Degree Course/Programs in the University, a candidate shall have to appear in an entrance test, namely Rajiv Gandhi University Common Entrance test (RGUCET)-2021, conducted by the University.
- b) Applicants for M.Tech. courses with valid GATE score and above a prescribed cut-off score, as decided by the competent authority shall be exempted from the Rajiv Gandhi University Common Entrance Test (RGUCET). The University shall reserve 25% of the total seats for applicants with a valid GATE score. In case of non-availability of such candidates, the seats shall be filled up through RGUCET.
- c) The syllabus for RGUCET for each PG program shall be the syllabus of the corresponding UG programme offered by the University. For M.Tech. (CSE), the syllabus shall be identical to the GATE syllabus for Computer Science & Information Technology (CS). For M.Tech. (ECE), the syllabus shall be identical to the GATE syllabus for Electronics and Communications (EC). For M.A. (Anthropology/ Education/Mass communication/MBA/MCA/M5W), the syllabus shall consist of English language, current affairs, general knowledge, reasoning, data interpretations/ numerical ability, and analytical skills. The question pattern and the pattern of the examination/evaluation etc. shall be as per the relevant guidelines and practice. In Group Discussion/Viva Voce for MBA, M.A in Mass Communication and MSW courses, the candidates will be called for group discussion and/or viva voce. The group discussion and/or viva-voce component will be of 25 marks. The cumulative marks obtained will be used to finalize the selection list of candidates.
- d) Mere appearance/qualifying/short-listing in the RGUCET shall not entitle a candidate for admission to any course/program in this University unless he/she fulfils the eligibility criteria fixed for the same. The candidate, if placed in the provisional admission list based on his/her performance in the RGUCET shall not be granted admission if he/ she does not meet the eligibility criteria.
- e) Admission granted shall be cancelled at any time, if it is found that the information furnished by the candidate is false or incorrect, or if, at a later stage, it is found that the candidate does not fulfill the eligibility criteria prescribed for the course/program.
- f) Individual Entrance Examination mark, rank and the list of selected/waitlisted candidates shall be hosted on the University website along with admission schedule/ Instruction.
- g) The provisional list of candidates shall be prepared on the basis of the marks secured in the RGUCET.
- h) Reservation of seats for various categories shall be in accordance with the rules/regulations/provisions/notifications of the Government issued and amended in this regard from time to time.
- i) Special additional weightage, over and above the mark secured in the RGUCET, shall be given to bonafide students from the affiliated colleges/departments of Rajiv Gandhi University Scheduled Tribe (ST) candidates from Arunachal Pradesh, studying in any UGC recognized Universities other than Rajiv Gandhi University/ Sportspersons/NSS Volunteers/NCC cadets, as prescribed by the University from time to time.
 - i. Candidates seeking admission under the reserved categories shall be required to fulfill the prescribed eligibility criteria for admission to the Course/Program.
 - ii. The relaxation in the minimum prescribed percentage of marks in the qualifying examination for admission to a Course/Program shall be permissible only in one of the categories.

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iii. If a candidate in the reserved category qualifies for admission in the open category, he/she shall be transferred to the open category without prejudice to the number of seats already allocated in that category which shall be offered to the next eligible candidate in that category.

iv. If sufficient number of candidates is not available in reserve category, such vacant seats shall be transferred to the ST category.

- j) For short-listing the candidates qualifying the RGUCET, the candidates shall be called for provisional Admission in the ratio of 3:1.
- k) The applicants, after qualifying the RGUCET, shall be required to appear in other additional test like group discussion, physical test, and personal interview etc., as decided by the competent authorities for admission to some specific courses/ programs. In such cases, the combined marks secure in all such tests shall be the criteria for admission. For short-listing the candidates qualifying the RGUCET, the candidates shall be called for other tests in the ratio of 3:1. The weightage for different tests shall be as per the following:



• Subject specific Proficiency Test includes Physical and Sports Proficiency test, Music/Fine Art proficiency test, etc.

- l. No Individual admission shall be sent to the selected/waitlisted candidates. The overall Merit Lists, Selection and Waiting Lists shall be hosted in the University website.
- m. However, merit shall remain the criteria for courses/program where entrance test is not conducted.
- n. The University shall reserve the right to increase/decrease the intake capacity of any of the Programmes along with the right not to offer any of its courses due to administrative reasons. The Self-financing Courses shall not be offered if sufficient number of students (decided by the concerned department) is not available.
- o) **RUGCET question Paper Pattern:** The question paper will contain 100 Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs) and will usually contain many sections:
1. 25 MCQs that examine language ability, reasoning, general awareness, mathematical aptitude/data interpretation and analytical skill expected of a University level candidate.
 2. 75 MCQs that examine domain knowledge of a given course.
 3. For interdisciplinary courses like M.A (Anthropology/ Mass Communication/Psychology/Tribal Studies), MBA, MCA and MSW all 100 MCQs will examine language ability, reasoning, general awareness, mathematical aptitude/data interpretation and analytical skills.
 4. Candidates will have to choose one correct answer. 1 mark will be awarded for every correct answer.
 5. Negative Marking: 0.25 marks will be deducted for every wrong answer.
 6. Duration: The written examination will be of two hours duration.

NB: The conduct of RGUCET shall be guided by the situation and condition or on subject to improvement in pandemic situation.


