In the overall interest of the intending candidates in the State of Assam, the Director of Secondary Education, Assam on behalf of the Inspector of Schools of the respective Districts (21 nos. of Plain Districts), invites online applications from intending and eligible candidates for the post of (1) Graduate Teachers (Arts), (2) Graduate Teacher (Science), (3) Graduate Teacher (Hindi) and (4) Assamese Language Teacher in Provincialised High/ Higher Secondary Schools in Assam in the Graduate Scale of pay of Rs.14,000/- to Rs.60,500/- and Graduate Pay Rs.8,700/- PM and other allowances as admissible as per rule.

Post details (district-wise, medium-wise and category-wise) shall be available from 12.00 Noon of 22nd September-2021 in the official website at www.madyamik.assam.gov.in. The provision of online application will open from 12.00 Noon of 30th September, 2021 and will be accepted till 12.00 Midnight of 31st October, 2021 in the official website at www.madyamik.assam.gov.in.

The candidate, who submits online application, shall select district, medium of school and category of post through the official website. Kindly visit official website at www.madyamik.assam.gov.in and visit recruitment tab and apply online. Candidates can appear in the interview in multiple Districts provided they are in a position to appear in such interview in view of the fact that the verification process at the District level will be conducted by the District Selection Committee, simultaneously in all the Districts at the same date and time.

(A) Minimum educational and professional qualifications for direct recruitment in the post of Graduate Teacher (Arts & Science).

- For the post of Graduate Teacher (Arts), the candidate must be Arts / Commerce Graduate or Post Graduate in Arts / Commerce having from recognized University with at least 50% marks in either Graduation or Post Graduation (or its equivalent) and Bachelor of Education (B.Ed.) from National Council for Teacher Education recognized Institution(s).
- For the post of Graduate Teacher (Science), the candidate must be Science Graduate or Post Graduate in Science having from recognized University with at least 50% marks in either Graduation or Post Graduation (or its equivalent) and Bachelor of Education (B.Ed.) from National Council for Teacher Education recognized Institution(s).
- In pursuance of the Govt. OM No. ASE 238/2014/213, dtd. 22.11.2019, those institutions having territorial jurisdiction outside the State of Assam but having a study centre in the State and such study centres if not recognized by DEC under UGC, the degrees / certificates issued by such off campus institutions shall not be considered as valid for the purpose of employment under Education Department. However, degrees / diplomas conferred by KHSOU, IGNOU, IDOL under Gauhati University and Distance Education under Dibrugarh University shall be considered as valid for the purpose of employment.
- In respect of Secondary TET Candidate must obtain 60% marks in each paper for UR category and 55% marks for OBC/MOBC, SC, ST(P), ST(H) and PwD category

(B) Minimum educational and professional qualifications for direct recruitment in the post of Graduate Teacher (Hindi).

- Pravin / Ratna in Hindi with 50% marks and degree qualification with 50% marks or post Graduate in Hindi in Arts with 50% marks from any recognized University.
Or
BA with 50% marks and having Hindi as one of the subjects with 50% marks or post Graduate in Arts with 50% marks provided that he has passed BA with one of the subjects as Hindi with 50% marks in Hindi
- B.T / B.Ed. degree from any recognized University (Parangat to be treated as B.Ed. degree).
- In pursuance of the Govt. OM No. ASE 238/2014/213, dtd. 22.11.2019, those institutions having territorial jurisdiction outside the State of Assam but having a study centre in the State and such study centres if not recognized by DEC under UGC, the degrees / certificates issued by such off campus institutions shall not be considered as valid for the purpose of employment under Education Department. However, degrees / diplomas conferred by KHSOU, IGNOU, IDOL under Gauhati University and Distance Education under Dibrugarh University shall be considered as valid for the purpose of employment.
- In respect of Secondary TET Candidate must obtain 60% marks in each paper for UR category and 55% marks for OBC/MOBC, SC, ST(P), ST(H) and PwD category

(C) Minimum educational and professional qualifications for direct recruitment in the post of Graduate Teacher (Assamese Language Teacher).

- BA with Hons / Major in the concerned subject with 50% marks and BT / B.Ed. degree from any recognized University.
- In pursuance of the Govt. OM No. ASE 238/2014/213, dtd. 22.11.2019, those institutions having territorial jurisdiction outside the State of Assam but having a study centre in the State and such study centres if not recognized by DEC under UGC, the degrees / certificates issued by such off campus institutions shall not be considered as valid for the purpose of employment under Education Department. However, degrees / diplomas conferred by KHSOU, IGNOU, IDOL under Gauhati University and Distance Education under Dibrugarh University shall be considered as valid for the purpose of employment.
- In respect of Secondary TET Candidate must obtain 60% marks in each paper for UR category and 55% marks for OBC/MOBC, SC, ST(P), ST(H) and PwD category

(D) In addition to the academic and professional qualification as per sub-rule 10 (5) Sub-Rule 1 (i) to (v) of the Assam Secondary Education (Provincialised Schools) Service Rules of 2018, the candidate must satisfy the following criteria:-

- In case of Assamese Medium School, the candidate must have passed HSLC or equivalent Examination with Assamese Language as one of the subjects or having Diploma in Assamese Language issued by the Avom Sahitya Sabha or read up to HSLC level in Assamese medium School.
- In case of Bengali Medium School, the candidate must have passed HSLC or equivalent examination with Bengali language as one of the subjects or having Diploma in Bengali language issued by the Barak Upatyakha Bangya Sahitya O Sankarita Sammelan or read up to HSLC level in Bengali medium School.
- In case of Hindi medium School, the candidate must have passed HSLC or equivalent Examination with Hindi language as one of the subjects or read up to HSLC level in Hindi medium School.
- In case of Bodo Medium School, the candidate must have passed HSLC or equivalent Examination with Bodo language as one of the subjects or read up to HSLC level in Bodo Medium School.
- In case of English Medium School, the candidate must have passed HSLC or equivalent Examination with Alternative English as one of the subjects or read from Class XI onwards in English Medium School.

Provided that for recruitment of teacher for teaching MIL subject, the candidate who passed HSLC examination with particular MIL subject shall be considered.

(a) Criteria for Selection of Graduate Teacher (Arts and Science):

- 100 marks on percentage of marks in B.A/B.Com/B.Sc. examination (in case of Major/Hons, the marks obtained in Major/Hons shall be taken into consideration).
- 100 marks on percentage of marks in HS final examination.
- 100 marks on percentage of marks in B.T/B.Ed. final examination.
- 100 marks on percentage of marks in TET examination or 60 marks for 15 years of experience as an undergraduate/Junior Teacher in a provincialised High/ Higher Secondary school having requisite academic and professional qualification. Any experience teacher who has appeared but could not secure the minimum qualifying 60 marks in the TET, shall be awarded at least 60 marks in respect of their experience if he or she has already completed 15 years of teaching experience. Any marks secured by such experienced teacher over and above 60 qualifying marks in TET shall be counted additionally in respect of TET for such teacher.
- Explanation: For the purpose of calculation of marks under the categories mentioned in clauses (ii), (iii) and (iv) above it may be clarified that if a candidate secures, for example 60% marks in the particular examination he/she secure 60 marks out of 100 marks allotted in the concerned examination.
- 50 marks @ 25 marks for one year of teaching experience as contractual teacher and another 25 marks for two years, subject to consideration for a minimum period of two years.
The Rule 10 (3) of the Assam Secondary Education (Provincialised Schools) Service Rules, 2018 prescribes that:-
"The teachers engaged on contractual basis in a provincialised Higher Secondary / High school under the Scheme "strengthening of secondary education" shall be given preference for recruitment to the post of Graduate Teacher by awarding total 50 bonus marks for their services as contractual teacher, i.e. 25 marks for one year and another 25 marks for completion of two years of service as contractual teacher, subject to consideration for maximum period of two years".
- 50 marks teaching experience for the teachers working continuously on fixed pay basis (other than contractual teachers) in a provincialised Higher Secondary School or High School/Madrassa for their service as fixed pay teachers provided they have requisite academic and professional qualification.
- 10 marks for NCC certificate (10 marks for "C" certificate and 5 marks for "B" certificate)
- 10 marks for participating in recognized sports at national level representing Assam.
- 10 marks for achievements in fine Arts and cultural activities representing the State officially at National level.

(b) Criteria for Selection of Assamese Language Teacher and Hindi Teacher:

- 100 marks on percentage of marks in BA Examination with the concerning language as one of the subjects or highest degree in the language i.e. Pravin / Ratna Examination in case of Hindi Teacher.
- 100 marks on percentage of marks in HS final examination.
- 100 marks on percentage of marks in B.T/B.Ed. final examination.
- 100 marks on percentage of marks in TET examination; provided that a special TET shall be conducted for language teachers comprising of the subjects of Pedagogy and Child Development, Language concerned and General Knowledge.

- 10 marks for NCC certificate (10 marks for "C" certificate and 5 marks for "B" certificate)
- 10 marks for participating in recognized sports at national level representing Assam.
- 10 marks for achievements in fine Arts and cultural activities representing the State officially at National level.

Other Criteria

- Separate Merit Lists will be prepared for each category of the post.
- The Graduate Teachers who are in service shall not be allowed to apply afresh for the post of Graduate Teacher.
- A candidate must not be less than 18 years of age and not more than 40 years for unreserved category, 42 years for Ex-Servicemen, 43 years for OBC/ MOBC and 45 years for SC/ ST(P)/ST(H) and 50 years for Persons with Disability (PwD) as on 1st January, 2021 as per Govt. Office Memorandum vide No. ABP/6/2018/51 Dated 02/09/2020 and subsequent Corrigendum No. ABP/6/2016/52, dtd. 20.02.2021. The eligible candidates shall apply online in the official website from 12.00 Noon of 30.09.2021 to 12.00 Midnight of 31.10.2021. No offline application will be accepted in this regard.
- The Online Applications and documents submitted by the candidates will be verified along with their original testimonials, by the District Selection Committee (DSC). The District-wise detailed schedule and venue for Screening/ Verification of documents will be notified in the official website. No TADA is admissible for verification process. District wise verification will be conducted simultaneously on the same date and time in the Districts by the respective DSC. Candidates will be informed either individually by the respective Inspector of Schools or collectively by the Director of Secondary Education, Assam in the official website.
- There will be reservation/ relaxation for Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) as per Govt. notification vide No. ABP/7/2019/4 Dated 10/04/2019.
- The Online Application and documents submitted by the candidate will be verified using modern technology with the help of DigLocker, Govt. of India and by scanning Barcode or QR Code for ensuring genuineness of the uploaded documents as well as by back office verification with the competent board/ council/ authority. But the authority if desires may conduct physical document verification at any point of time with proper notice.
- The candidate must ensure genuineness of all the information/ documents uploaded against the online application and he/ she will be solely responsible for the information/ documents uploaded against his/ her online application. Once uploaded there will be no scope of correction in respect of the credential submitted by the candidate. Any discrepancy will lead to cancellation of the candidature.
- The candidature will be cancelled forthwith, if any kind of fraudulent/ discrepancy regarding any information/ documents uploaded by the candidate is established by appropriate authority at any point of time. The candidate will be debarred from any future recruitment under Government of Assam and subsequent legal action will also be initiated against such candidate.
- In conformity with the "Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016" and in compliance Govt. in the Social Welfare Department vide SOP No. S.WD/290/ 2017, dtd. 28th July, 2017, it is specified that the reservation for persons with disabilities will be as follows:
 - 1% for blindness and low vision
 - 1% for hearing impaired and
 - 1% for locomotors disability or cerebral palsy.
- A candidate will mention and select the name of the districts for which the application is submitted.
- When the candidates appear for the verification before the DSC they must produce original certificates, testimonials and documents that was uploaded during the application stage.
- Reservation shall be applicable as per existing State Government Rules.
- Physical fitness as per Rule 11 of the Assam Secondary Education (Provincialised Schools) Service Rules, 2018.
A candidate for direct recruitment shall be :-
(a) of sound health both mentally and physically and free organic defect or bodily infirmity which is like to interfere with the efficient performance of his duties and
(b) required to undergo medical examination before appointment to the service.
- The Madrasa TET and Special TET for BTAD / Sixth Schedule shall not be considered in the recruitment process of Graduate Teacher ARTS / SCIENCE / HINDI / ASSAMESE LANGUAGE TEACHER.
- All communications including Corrigendum and addendum etc., will be published as and when required in the official website at www.madyamik.assam.gov.in

- Experience certificate (if any) of 15 years of teaching experience in undergraduate/junior teacher in provincialised higher secondary school.
- Experience certificate (if any) 1(one) year of teaching experience as contractual teacher.
- Experience certificate (if any) 2 (two) years of teaching experience as contractual teacher.
- Experience certificate (if any) of teaching experience for the teachers working continuously on fixed pay basis (other than contractual teachers) in a provincialised Higher Secondary School or High School/Madrassa for their service as fixed pay teachers provided they have requisite academic and professional qualification.(As per applicable, if any)

Please Note:

- After successful submission of the online form, candidates shall take a print out of the form and submit the same along with self-attested copies of mark-sheets and certificates in support of educational qualification, caste, disability, TET, B.Ed. and co-curricular activities at the time of document verification before the District Selection Committee. Candidates must also produce original documents that have been uploaded with the online application to the DSC etc.
- After submitting the online application form, the candidates will get a Unique Number against the submitted application and will keep the printout of the unique Number for all future references.
- Candidates may note that failing to qualify in Screening/Verification of documents will result cancellation of their candidature. Online communication in this regard will be entertained.
- The office will not be responsible for any lapse in submission of online application due to any technical problem.

 - Certificate of Achievements in sports at national level representing Assam
 - Certificate of Achievements in the arts and cultural activities representing the state officially at national level.
 - Certificate of Ex-servicemen issued by the Director, Sainik Welfare Board.
 - Certificate of EWS issued by the competent authority.

If any information declared by the candidate is found to be false at any stage, the candidate will be penalized as per prevailing laws/ rules.
