

**RAJIV GANDHI UNIVERSITY
ARUNACHAL PRADESH**

Rajiv Gandhi University is planning to re-open for offline functioning of academic activities for Lab based courses. However, the joining of the students to the campus will be carried out in a batch-wise manner. Firstly, the students of the Semester-III batches will be called, followed by the students of Semester-I batch which would be notified accordingly. All the students when called for in the campus are supposed to strictly adhere to the SOPs. The following measures will be enforced in the University premises:

1. The students returning back to campus will have to fill up an undertaking on the format signed by the individual student and parents and submit at the time of joining at hostel.
2. Vaccination is a must for every student and must have been administered the mandatory two doses. The proof of being fully vaccinated must be submitted to **Dr. Akin Tana Tara**, SMO, RGU Health Centre and also a copy to the warden
3. The boarders while coming to the University campus must carry RT-PCR/RAT and the certificate of Covid-19 test of not more than 72 hours must be submitted to **Dr. Akin Tana Tara**, SMO, RGU Health Centre and also a copy to the warden
4. In case a student in the campus is tested positive for COVID-19, the university will ask the concerned person to remain self isolation. Further, after the necessary isolation period he/she has to produce a negative RT-PCR/RAT test on joining back to campus.
5. Use of face mask is compulsory in the hostel, classroom and in the university campus. If anybody is found to be not wearing mask, a penalty of Rs. 500.00 (Rupees five hundred) only will be imposed on them.
6. Any kind of mass gathering / campaigning / public function, etc. is strictly prohibited in the hostel and university campus.
7. The boarders shall not leave the station/hostel without prior permission / approval of the warden. Anyone found doing so will be treated as absent from duty/hostel.
8. Entries to non boarders including relatives are restricted in the hostel.
9. Boarders will have to maintain the standard COVID-19 measures as notified by the University Authority, Government of Arunachal Pradesh and Government of India from time to time.



10. Anybody with sign & symptoms (cough, fever or difficulty in breathing) should inform to the SMO, RGU Health Centre and go for Covid-19 test.

11. Failing to abide by the prescribed guidelines the student is liable for any disciplinary action as per University Rules and Regulations and COVID-19 pandemic norms.
