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

**NOTIFICATION**

Pursuant to the decision taken in the 35<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Academic Council held on 27<sup>th</sup> November, 2021, vide item No.AC:35:08, on the matter pertaining to issues of granting renewal of temporary affiliation to the affiliated Colleges under Rajiv Gandhi University, the University Authority while endorsing the Academic Council approved recommendations of the committee constituted to review the issues of granting renewal of temporary affiliation to the affiliated colleges, hereby notifies that:

1. The authorities concerned of various affiliated colleges shall take appropriate steps to give boost to colleges lacking in required infrastructure and they must stressed upon improving the quality of higher education facilities in and through their respective colleges. In this regard, RGU will introduce and implement a new form and format of application for applying for affiliations to check and balance the functioning of colleges.
2. That, the University would grant and extend temporary affiliation up to a maximum period of 8 years only (First year as normal temporary affiliation and rest 7 years with annual renewal of the same). Within the period, from 5<sup>th</sup> year to 8<sup>th</sup> year all the temporarily affiliated colleges should apply for permanent affiliation maintaining all requisite criterions, by upgrading themselves. No further renewal of temporary affiliation shall be considered beyond the 8<sup>th</sup> year. Thereafter, if found to be unfit, such colleges shall be liable to be de-affiliated.
3. That, the Permanent affiliation to the Colleges will be considered by the University only after the completion of atleast five years of satisfactory performance after getting temporary affiliation and on attaining the academic and administrative standards as prescribed by the University/ UGC/ Statutory/ Regulatory Body concerned from time to time. Accordingly, a College shall apply to the University for Permanent Affiliation in the prescribed proforma along with the prescribed fee in favour of the Registrar. The continuation of temporary affiliation of the College is granted by the University on a year to year basis through inspection process and on approval of the Academic Council. Hence, the Colleges should apply for renewal of temporary affiliation well in advance. More so, the University shall levy certain penalty to colleges which fails to apply for renewal of affiliation within the stipulated time frame.

  
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4. Further, that, the permanently affiliated colleges shall be liable for review in every three years. On review, if found to be lacking in any criteria, shall be brought down to the status of that of a Temporary Affiliated ones; and further deterioration in quality may also lead to de-affiliation/de-recognition by the university without citing further reasons. Such reversals from Permanent to Temporary affiliated status shall be considered as a penalty and thus any fee deposited against Permanent Affiliation status shall stand forfeited and no refund will be entertained, whatsoever. All the colleges shall be required to submit the Annual Returns Reports (ARR) containing the updates on all data related to student's enrolment, faculty strength, and courses offered, etc. for preparation of Annual Reports, to the university on yearly basis.
5. Observing that, the degree of retaining teacher is a serious issue in colleges, the University Authority advocates that, the colleges should at least maintain retaining 25% of the teachers in their colleges for academic smoothness and flow. The college teachers should be paid the latest basic plus academic grade pay by their respective college managements as per UGC Regulation. In this regard, the copy of online payment roll should be shared with the University on monthly basis.
6. Viewing seriously on the seat increases in Colleges without the permission of the appropriate statutory bodies of the University, the university authority reiterates that, all such proposals must first come to University for approval in Academic Council. In this regard, a committee will be formed by the University Authority involving functionaries of both Govt. and private party run colleges alongwith the members from RGU to oversee such issues.


