The Academic Council perused and approved the AQAR, 2018-19 and 2019-20.


(ii) VISION-2032:

At the outset, Prof. Saket Kushwaha, Vice-Chancellor who is also the Ex-Officio Chairman of the Academic Council, Rajiv Gandhi University, welcomed all the esteemed members to the 34th meeting of the Academic Council and appraised the importance of the meeting. He informed that this meeting has been called on short notice to discuss the recently notified “**UGC Guidelines on Examinations and Academic Calendar in view of the COVID-19 Pandemic –July 2021**” and regarding an important ratification item with regard to the Vision, Mission & Objectives of RGU. The Registrar of RGU and Ex-officio-Secretary of AC Dr. N.T. Rikam stated that a four member committee has been constituted to work on Academic Calendar keeping in view the latest guidelines issued by the UGC. The committee has prepared the Academic Calendar accordingly which is being placed in the AC for deliberations and approval thereof. Thereafter, the Vice-Chancellor requested Dr. David Pertin, Jt. Reg. (Acad. & Conf.) to place the agenda items in the meeting. The following agenda items were discussed and deliberated:

AC:34:01: To discuss on the UGC Guidelines on Examination and Academic Calendar in view of the COVID -19 Pandemic –July 2021 and for effecting necessary adaptations there in.

AC noted that, RGU like any other universities in the country is in receipt of the UGC guideline on Examination and Academic Calendar in view of the COVID-19 Pandemic-July 2021, and hence the matter was brought to the Academic Council for deliberations and to suggest for way forwards. The UGC notifications and copy of Guideline were placed as **Annexure-1**.

The AC also noted that, RGU is on right schedule as per the revised academic calendar issued on 10th June, 2021, as it is in tune with the UGC timelines. More so, it was clearly mentioned that the academic calendar is subject to confirmation with the UGC guidelines. As such, any issues arising hereinafter could be thought upon and partially modified as and where required. Incorporations as per prevailing situations will be the need of the hour. Towards this, the University had constituted a 4 member committee on 19th July, 2021 headed by Prof. Utpal Bhattacharjee to prepare the Academic



Calendar based on the abovementioned UGC guidelines. The tentative Academic Calendar for the session 2021-22 prepared by the committee was placed as **Annexure 2**.

Meanwhile, the RGU vide a notification issued on 20th July, 2021, has postponed the RGU entrances till the first week of August, 2021, due to technical administrative reasons and dynamic situations of COVID-19 pandemic in the state in particular and the region in general. The RGUPET-2021 and RGUCET-2021 shall be held within 3rd August to 14th August, 2021. The schedule wise date sheet prepared by RGUCET committee was also placed in the AC.

After a threadbare discussion, the Academic Council unanimously approved the Academic Calendar for 2021-22 session of the Rajiv Gandhi University prepared by the committee which is in tuned with the timeline set for the coming Academic Year as per the UGC guidelines RGU received through Secretary UGC vide DO letter No.F.1-1/2021 (Secy), dated 16th July, 2021. The AC appreciated the University for being at least one month ahead of the set timeline of the UGC and for having completed the last Academic calendar with the UGC guidelines in right earnest. The AC also approved the RGUCET-2021 schedules in principle while expressing concern about the expected third wave of COVID Pandemic that might result in declaration of lockdown, micro-containment Zone and curfew in future. The AC further noted that COVID appropriate SOPs and other formalities needs to be followed by University community, so as to ensure completing of University activities smoothly within the specified timeframe. The AC members observed that if any department/faculty encounters any problem relating to compliance to examinations, the specific issue should be brought to the competent authority well in advance in order to ensure the timely completion and publication of results in accordance with the Academic Calendar 2021-22.



The Inspection team visited the college on 03 November, 2021, for verification and the committee submitted its report with recommendation for the renewal of Temporary Affiliation to the Namdapha Degree College, Miao, Changlang District, Arunachal Pradesh.

The AC approved the grant of renewal of Temporary affiliation to Namdapha Degree College, Miao, Changlang District, Arunachal Pradesh.

4. For the grant of renewal of temporary affiliation to Tadar Tanyang Govt. College Nyapin, Arunachal Pradesh.

The AC noted that the Principal, Tadar Tanyang Govt. College Nyapin, Arunachal Pradesh, has submitted an application for Permanent Affiliation. Accordingly, an Inspection Committee was constituted for Physical Inspection of the college under the Chairmanship of Prof. Oken Lego. The Inspection team visited the college recently, for verification and the committee submitted its report with recommendation for the renewal of Temporary Affiliation to the Tadar Tanyang Govt. College Nyapin, Arunachal Pradesh. The report was placed as **Annexure-21**.

The AC approved the grant of renewal of temporary affiliation to Tadar Tanyang Govt. College Nyapin, Arunachal Pradesh.

5. For the grant of renewal of temporary affiliation to Arunachal Community College, Itanagar, Arunachal Pradesh.

The AC noted that the Principal, Arunachal Community College, Itanagar, Arunachal Pradesh, has submitted an application for Permanent Affiliation. Accordingly, an Inspection Committee was constituted for Physical Inspection of the college under the Chairmanship of Prof. Tana Showren. The Inspection team visited the college on 24 November, 2021, for verification and the committee submitted its report with recommendation for the withdrawal of Temporary Affiliation granted to the Arunachal Community College, Itanagar, Arunachal Pradesh.

The report was placed as **Annexure-22**.

The house critically went through the report and was convinced that the said college is not fulfilling the required parameters, and unanimously decided to put the affiliation of the college under suspension and further decided that the college stops further taking admissions till further order.

6. To decide on CUCET.

The RGU Authorities had a virtual meeting with MoE officials and Professor Tiwari's



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committee recently and decided to form a committee to look into the interest of the local domiciles of the state for admission to different courses in RGU after bringing itself under the realm of CUCET.

The house noted the same and decided to be a part of it with certain preconditions to be determined upon to safeguard the interest of the domicile students of the state and the graduates for affiliated colleges of RGU.

- 7. To discuss on the implementation of extension of date of applicability of PhD as mandatory qualification for direct recruitment of Assistant Professor from 01.07.2021 to 01.07.2023.**

The AC noted that a letter received from MoE vide letter No.F.NO.3-3/2021-CU.CDN, dated 29.10.2021, stating that Ph.D is still not compulsory for being appointed as a faculty for certain period. The AC further noted that, the competent authority of the University has decided to implement the extension of date of applicability of PhD as mandatory qualification for direct recruitment of Assistant Professor from 01.07.2021 to 01.07.2023. The UGC letter on this was placed as **Annexure-23**.

The house noted the same and recommended that the same be placed in the 42nd meeting of Executive Council scheduled on 29.11.2021 for ratification.

- 8. To discuss on the case of forgery registered against the Teacher's Training College (BEd.), Aalo:**

The report submitted by the Prof. Tana Showren committee was presented before the house. **The members deliberated and accepted the same. The house however authorized the Vice-Chancellor to get legal opinion.**

AC:35.24 Reporting item: On XIX Convocation-2021.

The AC noted that, RGU continuing with its one of the best practices of conducting the convocations regularly on a fixed date since near about a decade is all set to conduct its XIX Convocation on 30 Nov., 2021. The Governor of Arunachal Pradesh and the Chief Rector of RGU, Brig. (Dr.) B. D. Mishra (Retd.) shall deliver the presidential address, while *Padmashri Prof. Jagmohan Singh Rajput, former Director, NCERT* shall attend and deliver the Convocation Address as the Chief Guest. Er. Taba Tedir, Hon'ble Minister of Education, Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh will be the Guest of Honour. Prof. Saket Kushwaha, the Vice-Chancellor shall be on Chancellor's duty in latter's absence and shall be admitting and awarding the graduating students with degrees.

The AC further noted that, a total of 7,664 students graduated in the academic session 2020-21 and shall be conferred with their degrees during the XIX Convocation. Of which 33 with PhD, 6 MPhil, and 913 post graduation and 6,712 undergraduate degrees. A total of 31 toppers in Post Graduation and 29 toppers in Under Graduation in various programmes will be awarded with Gold Medals. The topper among the post graduates will be awarded with Chancellor's Gold Medal while the topper of among the under graduates will be awarded with the Vice-Chancellor's Gold Medal. They will receive the medals and certificates in person during the Convocation's award ceremony. Besides, RGU also produced 105 Post Graduate Diplomas and scores of Diploma and Certificate holders in various fields.

The AC further expressed satisfaction that the varsity is not keeping any stone unturned to make the XIX Convocation a glorious event as always. A 11 member steering committee headed by the Vice-Chancellor and 15 sub-committees with equal number of Convenors and significant number of members comprising of both teaching and non-teaching fraternities were constituted for smooth conduct of the prestigious event.
