Rajiv Gandhi University in its pursuit of excellence in research and innovation participated in the North-East Research Conclave: Sustainable Science and Technology held from May 20-22, 2022 at the Indian Institute of Guwahati on invitation from the organising institute IIT Guwahati and Department of Education, Govt. of Assam. 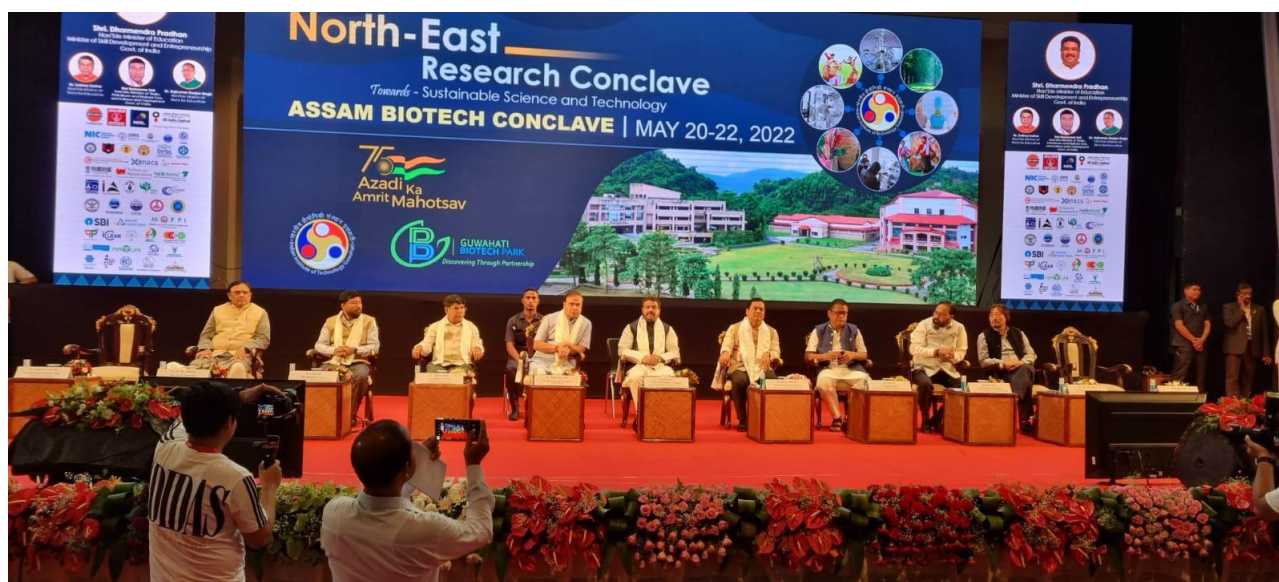
