Dear Mr. Palash Jyoti Gogoi,

I am happy to inform that on the basis of the interview conducted by the Centre for Nano and Soft Matter Sciences (CeNS) during 7 - 12 June 2021, you have been selected for provisional admission to the Ph.D. Programme* as a Junior Research Fellow (JRF).

As per the prevailing norms of the Department of Science & Technology, Govt. of India, JRFs are entitled to a Fellowship of Rs. 31,000/- per month. Hostel accommodation will be provided on first come first serve basis. As per the norms, you are mandatorily required to utilize the hostel facility of the Centre, subject to vacancy. In case of non-availability of accommodation, you may be provided accommodation in the Guest House temporarily for a short duration until vacancy arises in the hostel. In case of no vacancy arises during this short period, you will be advised to stay outside until vacancy arises in the hostel. HRA shall be admissible at Govt. of India rates for the period of such outside stay. You will be required to shift to the Hostel within one month from the date of notification of the vacancy, failing which the HRA component shall be discontinued.

Admission to the Ph.D. Programme requires mandatory acceptance and compliance of rules and regulations of the Centre including safe and proper laboratory usage. The students will be required to sign documents pertaining to such matters. Laboratory fees, medical fee and License fee etc. shall be applicable as per norms of the Centre and the fee structure is attached herewith.

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Your admission is subject to of the following conditions:


1. Production of Medical Certificate of Health and Physical Fitness issued by a Registered Medical Practitioner of the status of civil surgeon or a District Medical Officer, issued not earlier than a week before the date of admission.
2. You should ensure that both doses of vaccination against Covid-19 are taken before joining. It is mandatory to produce the Cowin certificate.
3. A RTPCR test report of not more than 48 hours prior, showing negative result, should be produced at the time of report.
4. You will have to undergo Quarantine time at the Hostel as per the norms, soon after reaching Bangalore.
5. Submission of documentary proof in respect of date of birth, permanent residential address. The original SSLC Marks Card, Degree Certificates furnished will be returned after verification.

Those candidates who hold valid fellowship from funding agencies such as CSIR will be required to register with the concerned agency soon after joining the Centre. Once the fellowship is granted the students will be governed by the norms of the funding agencies.

You may intimate your acceptance of the offer on or before 30-06-2021 by email to phdadmission@cens.res.in and also by remitting the one time refundable caution deposit and the first installment of the laboratory fee on or before 05-07-2021, failing which the offer is liable to be cancelled.

* The academic year begins on 1st of August 2021. However, due to the present pandemic situation we are unable to invite you to join in person at the Centre. Therefore, the actual date of joining will be intimated in due course. The fellowship will commence from the date of your joining the Centre, in person. You will receive an allowance of Rs.500 per month towards Internet charges till the date of your report to the Centre.

1. Refundable Caution Deposit

All PhD Students and Research Associates shall remit an amount of Rs.10,000 as Refundable Caution Deposit for Laboratory and Library purposes at the time of joining. This amount will be refunded to the Student/Research Associate at the time of relief from the Course on expiry of the complete term, subject to recoveries against damages or loss of books, if any, during the term.

2. Laboratory Fee

All PhD Students shall pay a sum of Rs.10,000 per annum (for every calendar year Jan-Dec) towards Laboratory Fee. The fees may be paid in one lumpsum or in two installments. Students enrolled in January batch shall pay by 15th of January and 15th of May of each year while those from the August batch shall pay by 15th August and 15th of December of each year.

A penalty of Rs.25 per day shall be levied for late remittance of fees.

3. Medical Fee

All PhD Students and Research Associates shall pay an amount of Rs.50/- per month towards Medical Fee. This shall be deducted from the monthly fellowship/salary bills. The medical consultation facility may be utilized on Tuesdays and Thursdays at the Centre's Clinic.
