The committee has furnished its report and the same was placed to AC as annexure-XIII.</p> <p>The Academic Council approved the same in principle.</p>

Law College, Jote, Papum Pare, Arunachal Pradesh, has submitted an application for renewal of Temporary Affiliation. Accordingly, an Inspection Committee was constituted for Physical Inspection of the college under the chairmanship of Prof. R.C. Parida. The Inspection team visited the college on 16 March, 2020, for verification and the committee submitted its report with recommendation for the renewal of Temporary Affiliation to the Jarbom Gamlin Govt. Law College, Jote, Papum Pare, Arunachal Pradesh. The report was placed to AC as Annexure-XIV.</p> <p>The Academic Council had a threadbare and after a thorough perusal of the report submitted by the Inspection Committee approved the extension of temporary affiliation for a period of one year. However, the College has to remove the lapses/observations made by the Inspection Committee before seeking another extension.</p> <p>It was also decided that the University will write a letter to all the Colleges to improve upon the observations as mentioned in the various Inspection Committee Reports at the earliest. Copy also should be marked to Commissioner to Hon'ble Governor, Arunachal Pradesh. Minister of Education, Secretary Education and Director, Higher &amp; Technical Education, Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh, Itanagar to this effect.</p>




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AC:31:17	<p>For the grant of renewal of Temporary affiliation to Donyi Polo B.ED College, Itanagar, Arunachal Pradesh.</p> <p>The AC noted that the Principal, Donyi Polo B.ED College, Itanagar, Arunachal Pradesh, has submitted an application for renewal of Temporary Affiliation. Accordingly, an Inspection Committee was constituted for Physical Inspection of the college under the chairmanship of Prof. Kesang Degi. The Inspection team visited the college on 22 February, 2020, for verification and the committee submitted its report with recommendation for the renewal of Temporary Affiliation to the Donyi Polo B.ED College, Itanagar, Arunachal Pradesh. The report was placed to AC as Annexure-XV. The Academic Council approved the same.</p>
