**Under the Any Other Item for discussion, the following decisions were taken;**

- (1) The matters pertaining to the cases of retiring Professors and Teachers on lien were discussed and decided that, they will be allowed to continue as Guide/Supervisor for the candidates who are enrolled and working under them.
- (2) The RB reiterated that publications in peered journals are mandatory for PhD scholars before the expiry of their first 3 years.
