
Rajiv Gandhi Organizes National Webinar on National Education Policy: One year of steady reforms, a few more miles to go...

On 10th August 2021, to mark the first anniversary of the new National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 a webinar is organized by the Faculty of Physical Education and sports Sciences, Rajiv Gandhi University, Arunachal Pradesh. This is the first education policy of the 21st century and replaces the thirty-four year old National Policy on Education (NPE), 1986.

Amid the pandemic uncertainty, we have completed one year of the announcement of NEP 2020, July 29. No policy announcement, since Independence, has attracted so much enthusiasm, curiosity and expectation as the one announced last year—an outcome of a massive consultative process, years of wait and against the backdrop of a nation's resolve to be self-reliant. The year-long, hectic, indoor preparations mark the rollout of the policy. Any policy of the scale and scope of NEP 2020 requires enabling legislation, framework, interdepartmental and inter ministerial dialogue at multiple levels.

Dr. Sambhu Prasad, Organising Secretary of the Program in his opening remarks briefed the audience about the objective of this webinar and also expressed his views about how New Education Policy 2020 Encourages Holistic Education through Sports and Play.

Due to unavoidable circumstances Professor Saket Kushwaha, the Vice Chancellor of the Rajiv Gandhi University was unable to attend the webinar so on his behalf Dr. Vivek Kumar Singh, Asst. Professor, Dept. of Physical Education conveyed his message to the audience in which he expressed that he was indeed delighted to see the department of Physical Education to organised this webinar to celebrate anniversary of NEP, 2020 and also observe Amrit Mahitsav.

Today he remembers the words of Swami Vivekanandje, "You will be nearer to heaven playing football than studying the Bhagavad-Gita." He pointed out that "Sports is about striving to be proud of your performance and not fighting in a negative way; it is about fighting to achieve something, in much the same way that Swami Vivekananda fought preconceived notions of people to make the world a happier and more peaceful place to live in," "You learn so much from playing in the field. You learn how to win and lose. A lot of character building happens on the playground. Through sports, you learn to appreciate others, and it opens the borders of your mind.

Professor Amitava Mitra, Pro-Vice Chancellor, RGU, extended his greetings and congratulates the Department of Physical Education to organize the webinar on NEP, he said Rajiv Gandhi University has organized all total seven webinar and out of that this is the second webinar organized by the Department of Physical Education in NEP 2020. He also expressed that NEP is a very revolutionary and visionary policy.

Dr. N.T.Rikam, Registrar was unable to attend the webinar because of some preoccupation in other assignment, so he conveyed his best wishes for the success of the program.

Dr. Tadang Minu Head, Department of Physical Education, RGU welcomed the dignitaries and highlighted the significance of National Education Policy in Physical Education and sports sciences at HEI.

Professor Sabyasachi Mukherjee, the officiating Vice Chancellor of L.N.I.P.E. Gwalior said that once the NEP gets implemented, children will benefit from the focus on balanced and all-round development from an early age. The new National Education Policy is a welcome change at a time when the health, happiness and immunity of children are becoming increasingly important due to the pandemic. The new NEP includes several key points that are instrumental for the holistic development of a child. By eliminating the rigid separation between curricular and extra-curricular activities, the NEP acknowledges sports to be equally important as any other subject like English or Science, thereby increasing the Fun and Engagement that children desperately seek in a school. Through Play, children can develop physically, mentally and socially. And we have also found Play to contribute positively to academic outcomes, classroom behavior and attendance levels. He also pointed out the six aspect of National Education Policy and also explained the year wise course structure.

Professor Biswajit Basumatary, Dean, NERC, L.N.I.P.E., Guwahati highlighted on Holistic education with sports-integration: Multi disciplinarity and holistic education are part of the key principles of the NEP. Along with subjects like the sciences and social sciences, the curriculum must contain courses that make education well-rounded, useful and fulfilling, including games, sports and fitness. The NEP also proposes other ways to increase school students' exposure to sports and other activities. It offers increased flexibility and choice of subjects, allowing students to choose physical education as part of the curriculum. The Policy also proposes 'bagless' days to allow students to engage in local vocational and other activities, such as sports and gardening. The NEP further encourages formation of clubs, including for sports, yoga, and health and well-being, at the levels of schools, school complexes, districts and beyond. Higher education institutions will also have departments in subjects like sports, art and music, to provide a multidisciplinary and stimulating environment. Credits will be given for such subjects in undergraduate programmes.

Dr. Anil Mili and Dr. K. Rojeet Singh were present in the programme. The webinar on National Education Policy was registered by 319 participants all across the country; this is a huge success in itself.
