

A BRIEF REPORT ON “WORKSHOP ON ASHING LANGUAGE DOCUMENTATION”



A Weeklong Workshop on ‘Endangered Languages and Cultures of Ashing (Adi) and Bogun Bokang (Adi) was held from 13th September to 18th September 2021 at CFEL, AITS, RGU under a research project on ‘**Documentation of Endangered Languages, Oral Narratives and Cultures of the Lesser-Known Tribal Communities of Arunachal Pradesh**’, supported by the North Eastern Council (NEC), Govt. of India.

During the workshop, 5 resource persons were invited from the Ashing community and 8 resource persons from Bogun Bokang. DugbangLipir, based from Tangam (Adi) community, also attended the workshop as a language consultant and interpreter for Ashing. The purpose of the workshop was to re-evaluate and cross-check the primary data for more authentication.
