THE CONCLAVE

Arunachal Pradesh, situated strategically in the border areas of the northeastern region of India, occupies 83,743 sq. kms and has a population of 1.3 million (2011 Census). It is the largest state in the region, yet with the thinnest density of population of only 17 persons / sq. km.

The State, rich in its diversity of communities is also abounding in natural resources- especially water and forests and has an equally vibrant flora and fauna. And while it contains a great cultural and natural resource diversity, it also has accompanying challenges.

With Arunachal having completed 30 years of Statehood, accompanied by changing aspirations of what constitutes the idea of development, a time has perhaps come to revisit its policy road map and shape a new development discourse for the State and its people.

It is with this backdrop that the present Conclave seeks to initiate a dialogue that will bring forth issues and concerns and emerge with a collective voice on how to perhaps re-frame policies and implement them for the holistic development of the tribal communities in the State.

The deliberations have been structured under the following thematic clusters:

1. Economy and Development
2. Expanding Agriculture and Allied Sectors
3. Challenges of Education
4. Skilling for the Future
5. Health Service Delivery
6. Protection & Continuity of Tangible & Intangible Heritage & Cultural Expressions



A major outcome of the Conclave will be a set of policy recommendations that will be synthesised from the deliberations and presentations, which will be placed for consideration during the planning process.

The State of Arunachal Pradesh, like other states in the extreme North East of India is a vast canvas for the inter-mingling of about 40 large and small tribes that inhabit the state. Like a wonderful soul woven in myriad colours & patterns, each tribe is distinct in its language, lifestyle, faith, traditional practices and even societal set-up. Yet with the coming of development in these recent years, the folklore and culture of these tribes have begun to feel the pressures of rapid change. In the absence of any written literature the histories of the tribes and invocations used at the time of rituals today survive only in the oral traditions, threatening to lose out on an entire value system that defined tribal life.

The Arunachal of today stands at a crucial point in its own history. The demands of modernization and change on the one hand, and a call for a return to roots on the other, have given rise to a process of questioning; sometimes even of the basis of the 'tribal identity'. This is often compounded with a feeling of alienation and lack of information that characterizes its relationship with the rest of the country. It was as a response to these circumstances that the Centre for Cultural Research & Documentation (CCRD) was set-up by the Sammanoy Gut Co-operative Society Ltd. in late 1997 with a view to observe, understand and audio-visually document this complex period of transition. It also sought to facilitate a better acceptance of the inevitable processes of change. We strive to provoke and initiate a dialogue on emerging equations with new environments.

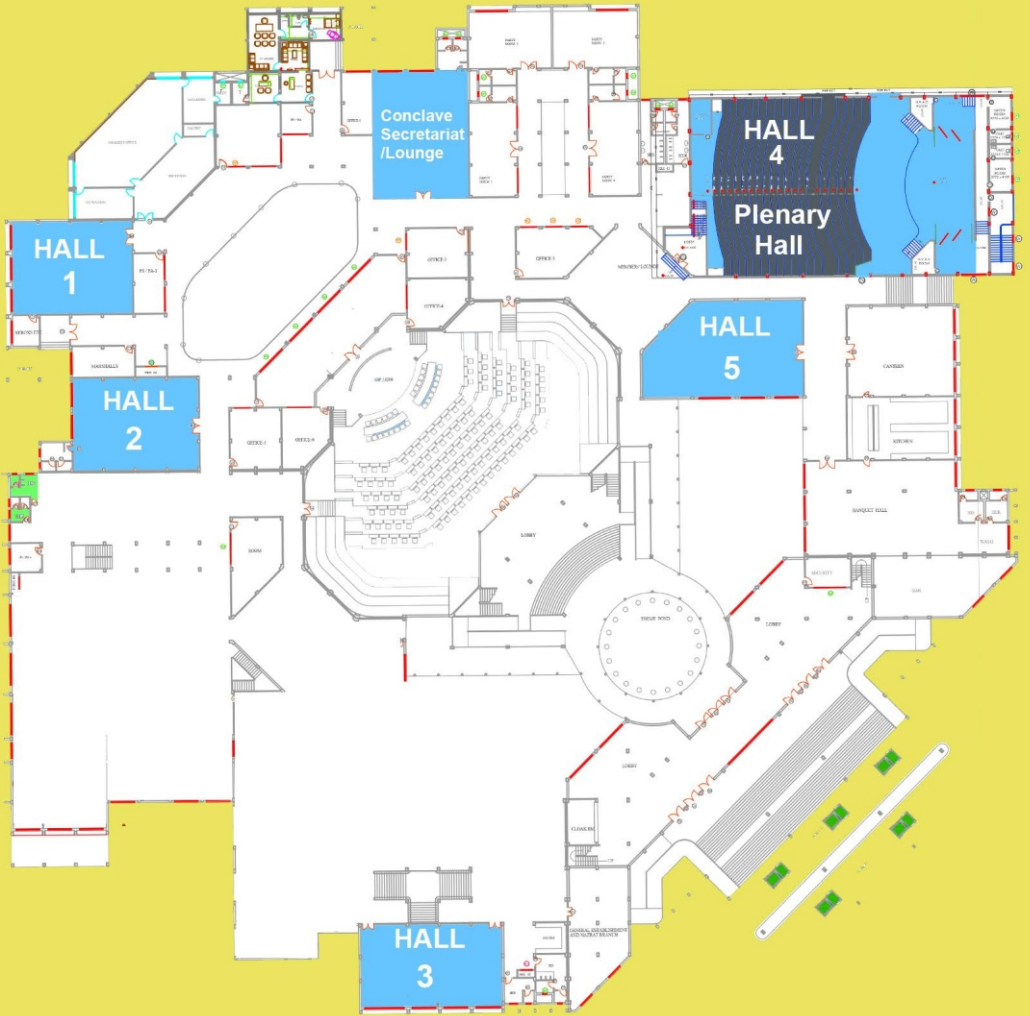
