**A Report**

Department of Anthropology conducted fieldwork every year as part of academic curriculum. Students of MA 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester were trained on different methods and tools of ethnographic research. This year a team of 24 students was led by Dr. Md. Asghar and Radhe Amung and conducted the fieldwork in Riloh village, Papumpare, Arunachal Pradesh for 18 days from 14<sup>th</sup> to 31<sup>st</sup> January 2020.

On 29<sup>th</sup> January, the team organized an outreach program at Rilohh secondary school as a gesture of gratitude to the people of Rilohh for their corporation throughout the field work. The outreach program was an honest endeavor on the part of Department of Anthropology, Rajiv Gandhi University Doimukh to reach out to the general mass of Rilohh to create awareness among them in respect of different issues and challenges faced by them and problems prevailing in . The program includes:

1. Awareness lectures on various issues for students
2. Drawing competition for lower class students
3. Quiz competition for higher class students
4. Plantation
5. Various cultural programs

#### Awareness Lectures

During the fieldwork, the team found that there is some cases of adolescence pregnancy and early child marriage. The team also observed various issues related to drug addicts. So, two separate lectures were arranged for boys and girls. The lecture was focused on early marriage, drugs addiction, career, education and also allotted separate time for responding to their queries.

#### Drawing Competition

A drawing competition was conducted for students up to class five. Students were categorized into three groups – class IV and V, Class II and III, Class I and below. Drawing sheet, pencil, eraser, cutter and color pens were provided to every student. The students of class IV and V category were given the theme “traditional house” for drawing. Rest of the students were asked to draw whatever they like. First, second and third in each category were given prizes.

### Quiz competition

Students of class VI and above were asked to form a team of three students each for participating in the quiz competition. They come up with six teams. The questions of the quiz were mostly based on state affair, science and technology and current affairs. There were four rounds of questions including one audio round. The villagers were also actively participated the event as there were questions for the audience with attractive prizes. Prize for First, Second and third were distributed at the end of the event. All the other teams were given consolation prizes.

### Plantation

A special plantation drive was conducted by the Anthropology team with the plantation of trees of different species around the premise of Government secondary school, Rilohh.

### Cultural program

In cultural program, the villagers and the students from the department of anthropology participated in various programs belonging to their own tribes.
