We seek your support in conducting data collection in Arunachal Pradesh as part of a research project titled "National Research on Human Trafficking in India (NRHTI)." The study is supported by Govt of India, UN, Tatatrusters and is being done under the supervision of NHRC.

The objectives of this research is to estimate the nature and extent of human trafficking in the country, assess the economics/ finances of human trafficking in India, understand the changing dimensions of human trafficking, identify social, economic, political, cultural causes at the household, community and regional level, trace the processes involved in human trafficking and understand the levels of exploitation, to examine the current response systems and to suggest and recommend the way forward to address the gaps identified through the research. Our Method of collecting data includes household level data collection, interviews with key informants and collection of other relevant secondary data from governmental and non-governmental institutions.
