National Service Scheme, under the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports Govt. of India, popularly known as NSS was launched in Mahatma Gandhi's Birth Centenary Year in 1969, in 37 Universities involving 40,000 students with primary focus on the development of personality of students through community service. From its inception, more than 3.75 crores students from Universities, Colleges and Institutions of higher learning have benefited from the NSS activities, as student volunteers. RGU NSS Cell has also been successfully implementing the various programmes under NSS for benefit of the Students. In pursuance to the UGC letter as received from Secretary UGC for implementation of NSS as elective subject in University. The proposal for implementing the same was initiated and placed in the 16th Academic Council meeting held on 22nd February 2016. The academic council approved the same. The Department of Social Work was entrusted to introduce the NSS as an open elective course. It is now successfully being taught with around 40 students enrolled every year.

As per the latest regulation of the UGC, a broad based IQAC was re-constituted in February, 2019 with the VC as the Chairman, Prof. A. Mitra Director, four Professors, two Associate Professors, four Assistant Professors, three administrative Officers, two Nominees from Alumni, two external experts as members.
