MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU) executed on 3<sup>rd</sup> (Tuesday) this day of September 2019 by the **Social Justice And Empowerment And Tribal Affairs**, Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh, Itanagar ,PO/PS Itanagar , District PaumPare , and **Rajiv Gandhi University, RGU, Rono Hills, Doimukh**, Arunachal Pradesh.

The "Department" and "Institution," wish to establish a cooperative relationship through mutual understanding in the areas of education and research studies , agree as follows:

**ARTICLE 1: SCOPE OF THE COLLABORATION**

The areas of collaboration include activities or programs offered at Building Infrastructure

- 1. State-of-the-Art building for TRIs/ National TRIs**
- (ii) Repairs /Augmentation /Up gradation of existing TRI Building excluding routine maintenance like house-keeping, day to day maintenance, utility bills etc.
- (iii) Support for setting up of Tribal Museum / Memorials including virtual museums.
- (iv) Support for setting up of libraries including Digital Repositories.
- (v) Conference Hall, Training / Resource Centers, training hostels in TRI building.
- (vi) Setting up of tribal food cafe, Artisans, Exhibition-cum- Sale outlets of tribal art & artifacts, souvenirs, etc. in TRI/Museum campus, or at other places in, the State.

**2 Research & Documentation (including Audio/ Video/ Virtual Reality (VRy Augmented Reality (AR) & new technologies):**

- (i) Tribal welfare measure
- (ii) Success stories.
- (iii) Tribal Profile.
- (iv) Tribal language, culture, traditions, customs, art & artefacts, traditional medicinal practices, tribal myth & stories, tribal cuisines and other special characteristics
- (v) Monitoring and evaluation of various government interventions.
- (vi) Development and printing of primers in local tribal languages.
- (vii) Any other aspects relating to tribal art, tradition and culture

**3 Training and Capacity building:**

- (i) Laws/constitutional provisions in respect of Scheduled areas / tribal rights. (Including FRA, PESA, Prevention of Atrocity Act, L&RR, and Land Acquisition etc.)
  - (ii) Capacity building of functionaries and tribal representatives on socioeconomic programs.
  - (iii) Capacity building of Artisans- Art & craft Metal craft, painting, dance/drama, textiles, handicrafts as well as value addition to art, craft and designs etc. This can include kits etc.
  - (iv) Conducting of Seminars, Conferences, Workshops on various tribal related issues.
  - (v) Think tank related activities.
4. Many tribal festivals/ yatras etc. are celebrated in States, which can be publicized at National Level to attract more tourists, TRIs may propose such festivals/ yatras etc. for supplementary support under the scheme.
  5. Organizing "exchange of visits by tribal community ": TRI shall arrange visit to other parts of the State/Country. The visiting groups may comprise of people for various tribes, have adequate representation from women and officials. The objectives should include to get a wider perspective of culture and traditions, to learn about socio- economic development/ best practices of other areas and to see how TRIs can be managed more efficiently and to see how socio-economic development can happen without losing core culture etc.
  6. Innovative projects /initiatives / activities, which can help the tribals or tribal majority area.

**ARTICLE 2: GENERAL AREAS OF COOPERATION**

2.1 This MOU is not binding on department and institution but is intended to facilitate discussions relative and exchange information , but not limited, to the following general areas of cooperation. Specific activities and programs implemented under authority of this MOU shall be subject to availability of funds and the approval of department and institution's authorized representatives,

2.2 Prior to initiating any specific activity or program contemplated by this MOU, the department and institutions will enter into a separate MOU signed by each of their authorized signatories that describes the terms of the arrangement, including the budgets. The Department and institution will designate a Liaison Officer to develop and coordinate specific activities or programs.

### 3 . Funding:

3.1 Funding under this Scheme would, however, be 100% grant-in-aid by the Ministry of Tribal Affairs to the TRIs on need basis with the approval of APEX Committee. TRIs would be responsible to prepare proposal and detailed action Plan for the year along with budgetary requirement and submit it to the Ministry through State Tribal Welfare Department.

4. The department of SJE&TA, after obtaining FD's Concurrence and completing all formalities shall transfer the Fund/deposit the fund to the bank account of RGU, Rono Hills , Doimukh through PFMS for further transfer of funds to the respective HOD's to carry out the research programmes.

5. The further funding to the respective departments ;i.e. Dept. of Sociology, ~~dept~~ of Arunachal Institute of Tribal Studies and Dept. of Anthropology will be through the concerned authority of Rajiv Gandhi University , Rono Hills , Doimukh, Arunachal Pradesh.

The Concerned Authority of Rajiv Gandhi University will sanction the fund to respective above mentioned departments for the execution of all the projects/Programs.

6. The Funding Pattern to the respective departments will depend subject to release of fund by MOTA, GoI.


7. The proposals shall be accompanied by utilization certificates as per provisions of GFR.

8. The Concerned HOD's of Departments will submit the UC Signed by Finance and Accounts Officer(FAO) and Concerned HoD's of Department and counter signed by Registrar, RGU.

9. The Proposal should show all the item wise expenditure involved .

### 10. Monitoring:

Each TRI shall have its own web portal. All documents to be put there as well as MoTA repository. The Ministry of Tribal Affairs, Government of India will carry out concurrent monitoring through physical and financial reports and visits by officers of the Ministry to review the scheme. The activities approved by the APEX Committee will be reviewed on quarterly Basis and an appropriate mechanism shall be devised.
