#### AC.18:06: TO APPROVE THE SYLLABUS OF M.Tech. (CSE)

The A.C. noted that the University has prepared the syllabus for the M.Tech (CSE) and submitted to the A.C for approval.

The Council, after going through the syllabus, approved the same for implementation from the current academic session 2006-2007.

#### AC:18:07: TO APPROVE THE U.G. SYLLABUS OF ANTHROPOLOGY

The Council noted that in the U.G. syllabus for anthropology, 10% modification has been effected and placed before the A.C. for approval.

The A.C. approved the modification in the Anthropology Syllabus.

#### AC.18:08: TO APPROVE THE GUIDELINES OF VARIOUS COURSES IN RGU.

The Council noted that the Drafting Committee has submitted guidelines for various degree/diploma/ short term certificate courses viz. Post Graduate Diploma in Mass Communication(PGDMC), Post Graduate Diploma in Hospitality Management and Tourism(PGDHMT), Diploma in Computer System Maintenance(DCSM), Certificate Course in Disasters Management(CCDM), Certificate course in Geographical Information System(CCGIS), Certificate Course in Teaching Mathematics(CCTM) and Certificate Course in Applied Fisheries(CCAF), M.B.A and M.Tech. (CSE).

After deliberating on the guidelines, the Council recommended to Executive Council for approval. However, the fee structure shall be worked out by a committee as per university norms.

### AC.18:09: TO APPROVE THE SYLLABUS OF TRIBAL STUDIES IN CDE,RGU.

The A.C. perused the syllabus for Tribal Studies in the Centre for Distance. Education (CDE-RGU) prepared by the Board of Studies and submitted by the Director, CDE.

The Council approved the same for its implementation from the Academic Session 2007-08.
