INTRODUCTION TO THE EVENT:

The 18th edition of the UNIFEST got off to a colourful start amidst huge gathering at Rajiv Gandhi University campus. The XVIII Uni-fest of the Rajiv Gandhi University a 3 day event was conducted w.e.f., 7-10 November, 2017. The uni-fest promotes and rejuvenates literature, culture, games and sports with a motive to achieve ultimate human excellence. SUMMARY OF THE EVENT:

The XVIII Uni-fest of the Rajiv Gandhi University a 3 day event was conducted w.e.f., 7-10 November, 2017. The inaugural programme of Unifest was held on 7th in a spectacular note amidst a gathering of student, faculties and university staffs.



Attending the inaugural event, All Arunachal Pradesh Students' Union (AAPSU) President Hawa Bagang encouraged the students to be pragmatic, maintain practicality and focus on studies. He cited many examples how university students should contribute to the welfare of the student's community and general public. He expressed his concern regarding the money culture in the student's union elections in the state. He said, "Only politicians are not to be blamed for any unaccomplished aspirations of the society because every individual, from bureaucrats, technocrats, and students to the common public, has a role to play for the development of the state and nation as a whole."



Addressing the students, AAPSU General Secretary Tobom Dai said, “Uni-fest is a very attractive programme, yet a source of distraction from academic performances.” He also encouraged the students to embrace their cultural identity with pride. Vice Chancellor of RGU, Professor Tamo Mibang spoke about the changes RGU has undergone from 1974 till the present time and how the number of departments came into existence.



The University festival or popularly known as Uni-fest is conducted annually by the Students’ Union of RGU in order to harness the skills of students at every field. Various competitions such as sports, track and field, literary and cultural events will be organized during the three days event.



Earlier, the students participated in a mega welcome dance representing the different tribes of the state in a single show dance symbolizing unity in strength. Students from the Department of Yoga demonstrated the yogic abilities to heal illness with asanas.



Speaking at the valedictory function as chief guest, RGU vice chancellor Prof Tamo Mibang stressed on the importance of physical education. Stating that many youths of the state are in the University, Prof Mibang asserted that the RGU should be the centre of learning in the state.





The three- day long XVIII Uni-fest 2017 of Rajiv Gandhi University (RGU) concluded with Dorjee Khandu house emerging as the overall champion. Four houses namely, Dorjee Khandu, Tadar Tang, Talom Rukbo and Daying Ering competed during the three day event, showcasing true sportsmanship in every field. The competition witnessed many nail biting encounters but in the end the Dorjee Khandu house grabbed the title of Champion House along with other titles like Best Cultural and the Best Games and Sports House. Also, Tate Tayam of Tadar Tang House and Machundu Pulu of Daying Ering House were adjudged Mr and Ms Uni-fest 2017 respectively. During the Valedictory Ceremony the Guest of Honor Shri Meje Taku, Vice President AAPSU, addressed the gathering and congratulated the winners and participants and also encouraged all to come up with more enthusiasm in future years.

many more. The Cadence 2018 is being participated by 12 colleges affiliated to RGU from different parts of the state.



Rijju in his speech advised students to participate in this festive as one mind and one thought so that the sense of unity can be harnessed in a broader sense. He also added that the cadence is a gathering of intellectuals which will provide the potential to influence the future of North East. Accepting the memorandum submitted by RGUSU and officers club Rijju gave assurance to do anything in his power to fulfil the same. He has agreed with RGUSU about the needs of having a regular Vice Chancellor.



The Cadence 2018 will be a three days long festival starting from 22nd to 24th wherein different college students will lock horn in literary and cultural events.

Registrar Prof. Tomo Riba, who is also the Organizing Chairman informed the gathering that, 15 colleges from across the state are expected to participate in the event, each with a troupe strength of 20 students, accompanied by 2 teacher escorts.



The participants competed with each other for awards in 6 cultural, 4 literary and 5 art events and for the title of Mr. and Ms. Cadence aside from the best Disciplined and Champion's trophy.

MLA, Koloriang Shri Pani Taram will attend as Chief Guest of the cultural events on 23rd April, Arunachal while Shri Kumar Waii, Home Minister Govt. of AP attended the Valedictory programme on 24th April as the Chief Guest.

Dera Natung Government College walked away with the champion's trophy at the conclusion of the 12th edition of Rajiv Gandhi University's (RGU) Inter College Youth Festival, 'Cadence', on Tuesday.



Home Minister Kumar Waii, who attended the function urged the students to utilize their time in absorbing practicable knowledge that can sustain and support life in every sphere. Expressing concern over the degrading quality of education, the minister said, "The quality of education determines our destiny, and it becomes our weapon." Waii also lamented the "extortion culture" being practiced by educated members of the student community who go

to government offices and demand work. “These practices are constantly compromising the quality of education amongst our youth,” he said, adding that reading books would be to no avail unless the students learn something of practicable value. Citing the potential for employment and livelihood generation in the tourism sector in Arunachal, he underlined the importance of co-curricular activities and how they build confidence and soft skills.



State BJP President Tapir Gao described students as “ambassadors for sustaining cultural identity for posterity” and urged them to preserve their native culture. “As tribals, we should at least use the tribal terms of address instead of anglicized words like Papa, Mummy and Daddy,” he said, and emphasized that “identity can be secured by gaining right knowledge and respecting the cultural values which have been followed.”





Gao expressed concern over contemporary student politics “where the money culture has corrupted the mind of our youths” and stressed the need to instead work hard, especially in the present competitive society.



Waii and Gao later gave away the prizes to the winners of various competitions. Saint Claret College (Ziro) bagged the best disciplined team and the best cultural team awards, while the literary award was taken by Jawaharlal Nehru College (Pasighat). Doying Gumin College (Pasighat) was declared the best runner-up team, and Dera Natung Govt College (Itanagar)

walked away with the champion's trophy.


