

Evolution of the University

Rajiv Gandhi University (RGU), formerly Arunachal University nestled atop Rono Hills on a picturesque tableland of 302 acres is a premier institution of higher education in Arunachal Pradesh and has completed nearly four decades of its existence (since 1984). The foundation stone of the University was laid on 4th February, 1984 at Rono Hills, Doimukh, by the then Prime Minister of India. After being renamed as Rajiv Gandhi University (2005), the University was converted into a Central University with effect from 9th April, 2007.

The University received academic recognition under section 2(f) from the University Grants Commission on 28th March, 1985 and started functioning from 1st April, 1985. It received financial recognition under section 12B of the UGC on 25th March, 1994. The University started its academic journey in the year 1988 with 48 students, 18 faculty members, and three departments namely History, Political Science, and Education.

16. MAJOR TOURIST ATTRACTION:

1. Indira Gandhi Park:

The park is 1km from Ganga Market and is a most commonly visited place in Itanagar. It is a local recreational garden with a provision for jogging. It has a meditation centre. Tourists with family find the park beautiful where they can enjoy scenic beauty and greenery all around.



2. Itafort:

The place is 2 kms from Ganga Market. An important place to visit in Itanagar, the name literary means 'Fort of Bricks' (brick being called 'Ita' in the Assamese language). The port has an irregular shape, built mainly with bricks dating back to the 14th-15th century. The total brickwork is of 16,200 cubic meters which was built by the kings of the Chutiya kingdom which ruled the region during that time. The fort has three different entrances from three different sides, i,e, the western, the eastern and the southern sides.



3. Ganga lake:

It is also known as the Gyangkar Sinyi, 6 km from Ganga Market, Itanagar which is a must visit place in Itanagar. Ganga Lake is a major tourist attraction and it is one of the most visited and popular locations in Itanagar. Tourists from across the world visit this destination for recreational activities and it hosts a perfect place for dry picnic. Since the lake is still, one can notice its colour to be green.



4. Gompa:

A Buddhist Temple located 3 kms away from Ganga Market is a site of tourist attraction at Itanagar. An excellent Buddhist gate at the base of the hill and a road spiralling up the hill takes all the way to the Gompa located at the top. The Gompa is very near to the main highway. However, the monastery is separated from the rest of the town by a small hill. It is one of the most peaceful and serene places in Itanagar.



5. Polo Park:

The park is 9 kms from Ganga Market and located at Naharlagun. An astounding botanical park at the top of the ridge, this park is a must visit for tourists. The view from the park is excellent as it is a view point for the town of Naharlagun.



6. Jawaharlal Nehru State Museum:

The Museum is located at a distance of 3 kms from Ganga Market. The museum divided into sections was established by the state government in 1980s. Each section displays an extensive gamut of handicrafts, reminiscent of traditional Arunachal Pradesh and archaeological findings of the region. A visit to the museum restores faith in handicrafts and gives a glimpses of the rich artistic culture of the region.



7. State Zoo:

It is 4 kms away from the Ganga Market which is another point of tourist attraction at Itanagar. The zoo is one of the fascinating places for children and the best for family tour and day out. Species like Himalayan Black Bear, Royal Bengal Tiger, Panther, Leopard, great Indian Hornbill and many rare birds are the main attraction of the state zoo.




