



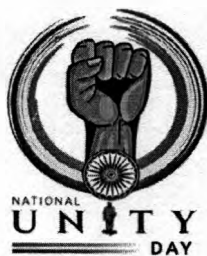

As you are aware, India has made history as its Chandrayaan-3 became the first to land on the south-pole region of the Moon on 23rd August 2023. Beyond its immediate scientific impact, this holds the promise of inspiring young minds to join the realms of space exploration and science.

In order to celebrate this significant achievement, a Mega Town Hall will be organized in a hybrid format by connecting about 200 HEIs. Hon'ble Prime Minister will address this Town Hall. At this event, ISRO scientists will make a presentation. After the presentation, scientists will address the students and answer their queries. The tentative date for the Town Hall would be 4, 5, or 6 September 2023, which will be shared in our subsequent communication. Higher Education Institutions may make necessary arrangements for the benefit of students.

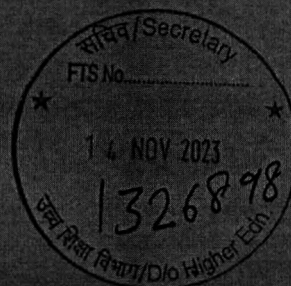

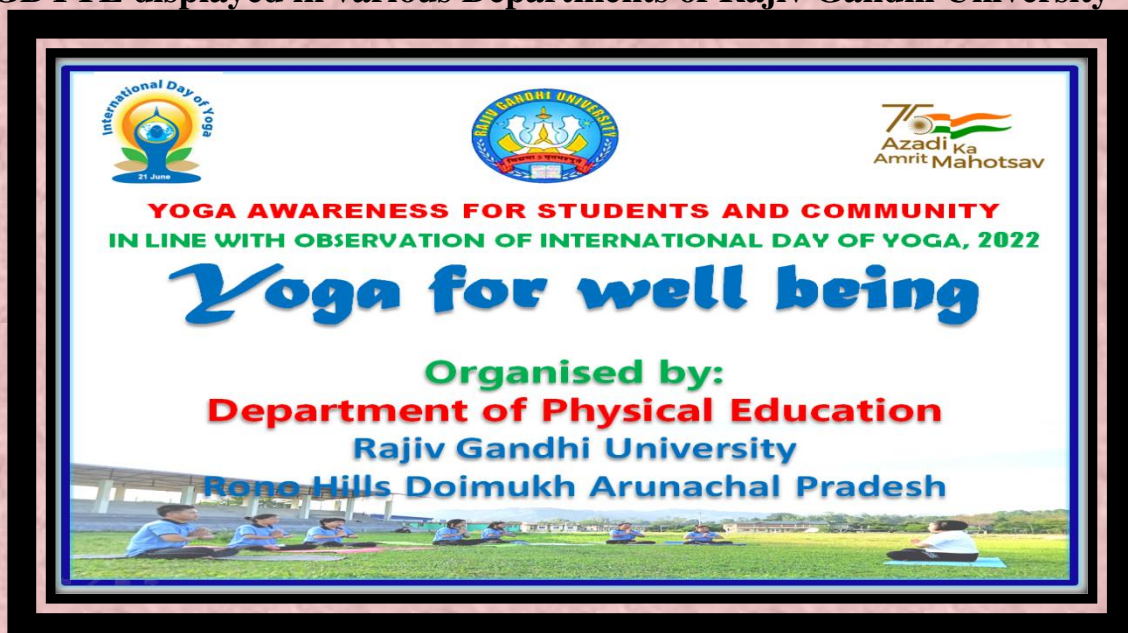
