**NOTIFICATION/GUIDELINES FOR ADMISSION**

Rajiv Gandhi University has notified inviting online application through Samarth for admission to various Postgraduate, Undergraduate//Diploma/Certificate courses and Ph.D for the academic session 2024-25. For verification, scrutiny of applications and determining eligible candidates/students for admission following guidelines shall be taken into consideration and adhered strictly:

1. Admission to various Post Graduate/ PG Diploma/ Graduate (LLB, BEd, BPEd) programmes shall through CUET-PG and RGUCET/PET.
2. For Post Graduate / PG Diploma / Graduate (LLB, BEd, BPEd) programmes: Out of total intake seat:
  - a. 20% shall be through CUET-PG and
  - b. 80% through RGUCET.
3. For Ph.D programme, admission shall be through RGUPET only.
4. No Sports quota/ supernumerary quota will be available for candidates applied through CUET PG as only one seat each is available. Only in case of there is no such candidate from RGUCET pool, the vacant seat will be passed on to the CUET-PG pool.

**General guidelines**

1. Admission guidelines, reservations of seat, weightage to RGU passed and ST candidates shall be applicable in both the CUET and RGUCET category.
2. Award of bonus marks weightage for admission wherever applicable such as incase of NSS, NCC, etc shall be replaced/converted to percentile points-based weightage.
3. For supernumerary and sports quota the allocation shall be done from RGUCET category only.
4. Reservation for Ex-Service men, Sports quota and Physically challenged shall be as per government of India guideline.
5. Disability of upto 40% as certified and issued by the Disability Board in a prescribed format shall only be accepted.
6. For sports quota, National and International events certificate since 5(five) years shall be considered valid for admission only.
7. Admission to all PG course shall be strictly as per merit list of CUET and RGUCET 2024 including, B.Ed and LLB, BPEd
8. Counseling shall be done by respective departments on Physical as well as online mode, to all students who have applied for admission through CUET-PG 2024.
9. For admission to Ph.D under NET category, score/mark statement issued by UGC/ICSR should be submitted for considering eligible to appear Viva-voce.
10. Admission to Certificate courses in university shall not be through RGUCET but based on merit of last examination eligibility criteria only.
11. Any seat reserved under a quota shall be beyond the intake capacity.
12. Admission to all undergraduate courses with minimum eligibility of 10+ shall be through CUET-UG 2024 only. Timeline of admission and other formalities shall be as per NTA notice. However, all admission conditions/reservations shall be as usual.
13. For Undergraduate courses departments in RGU and affiliated Colleges shall submit detail report of admission done under CUET-UG 2024 immediately of admissions are over.

**SoP for CUET-PG based screening, counseling and admission:**

1. Students who applied through CUET-PG 2024 category:
  - a. Their CUET score is available in the Excel sheet. (in the folder shared at Departmental level)
  - b. The Department will screen for eligibility criteria as per the "programme and eligibility list".
  - c. The candidates will be given due weight according to RGU Guidelines. (followed last year/updated percentage points for NSS NCC etc)
  - d. Category-wise list will be prepared containing all applicants, irrespective of final result of qualifying exam available with the candidate or not.
  - e. The candidates will be notified through their email individually:
    - i. Application Number
    - ii. Name
    - iii. Programme
    - iv. Date and Time window of counseling (physical / online)
    - v. Get their credentials
    - vi. If physical, they should appear with credentials
    - vii. If online, the candidate should request for it and may be provided with Google meet link.
  - f. Counseling will mainly focus on:
    - i. Whether belong to requisite subject domain?
    - ii. Qualifying Exam passed or result is awaited.
    - iii. If passed, whether the mark sheet is uploaded in the Samarth portal during application?
      - a) If no, send a copy on HoD email
      - b) If yes, update in the database.
    - iv. If result is not declared- When is the final result expected?
    - v. Whether the candidate is having back papers in any previous semester
      - a) If 'yes', has the candidate appeared for the exam for clearing the backlog?
    - vi. Willing to take admission in the programme?
    - vii. If yes, send them the link for payment of non-refundable "Seat retention fee" of Rs. 1000.00
    - viii. If no, whether willing to be considered at later stage (subject to availability of seats)
    - ix. The number of candidates advised to deposit "Seat retention fee" should not exceed the number of seats available in that category.
    - x. Rest will be advised to 'wait and watch'.
