#### E. General Instructions

1. Applications should be submitted online only by visiting the CU-UGC Chayan Recruitment Portal at <https://curec.samarth.ac.in/>
2. Applicant shall have to first register on the CU-UGC Chayan Portal, after which, they can fill up the prescribed electronic application form online.
3. Before filling up the online application form, candidates must go through the “User Manual” and other resources available on CU-UGC Chayan portal – <https://curec.samarth.ac.in/index.php/search/site/resources>

5. On successful submission, the applicant will come across a link to download a PDF of the application and proof of payment details, which he/she will have to print and produce the hard copy if called for interview.
6. Before applying for a post, applicants are advised to go through the relevant UGC AICTE/ NCTE/ ICAR norms/ regulations as amended from time to time and as applicable, as well as contents of the advertisement carefully and satisfy themselves about their eligibility. No enquiry in this regard will be entertained.
7. Applicants applying for more than one post/ department must submit separate application and pay requisite fees.
8. Applicants need to submit separate forms for Unreserved post and reserved post and accordingly pay requisite fees.
9. All supporting documents duly self-attested must be uploaded online on the Recruitment Portal of the University. Scrutiny shall be done purely on the basis of the claims supported by valid documents uploaded on the recruitment portal of the University while filling up the form. Printed copy of the filled in application form along with all the original documents should be produced at the time of interview.
10. University reserves the right of deciding the disciplines as concerned/ allied / relevant while scrutinizing the applications.
11. Reservation for the SC/ST/OBC (Non-Creamy Layer)/PwBD/EWS applicants will be as per the Government of India policies. Applicants seeking reservation benefits available for SC/ST/OBC (Non Creamy Layer)/PwBD/EWS categories must upload the necessary documents justifying the claim of respective reservation as per Government of India norms. The certificate uploaded should be in the latest format prescribed by the Govt. of India and issued by the competent authority.



12. Relaxations and concessions for SCs/STs/OBCs will be applicable in accordance with reservation policy of the Govt. of India and subsequent clarification/directives issued from time to time to this effect.
13. Applicants belonging to OBC are required to submit valid and latest certificate regarding his/her OBC status and belongingness to “Non Creamy Layer (NCL)” form the appropriate competent authority.
14. Candidates applying under EWS category must submit valid Income & Asset certificate for EWS as per the notification of Government of India along with the application.
15. Candidates applying for PwBD reservation must submit valid certificate of disability in prescribed format in this regard as per GoI rule 18(1) issued by competent authority.
16. Relaxations and concessions for persons with disabilities will be applicable in accordance with reservation policy of the Govt. of India and subsequent clarification/ directives issued from time to time to this effect.
17. Relaxation of 5% will be provided from 55% to 50% of the marks at the Master’s level for the SC/ ST/ OBC (NCL)/ EWS/ PwBD categories for the purpose of eligibility and assessing good academic records.
18. Applicants who are in service should route their application through proper channel or should submit a "No Objection Certificate" from the employer along with the application, failing which their application will not be considered further.
19. Selection of a candidate to the posts of Assistant Professor, Associate Professor or Professor in various faculty/ departments of the University shall be on the basis of merit on the recommendations of the duly constituted Selection Committees.
20. Applicants should possess the prescribed qualifications, experience and eligibility criteria as on the closing date of application, as prescribed by the University from time to time for the respective posts. All the above posts carry UGC pay scales plus admissible allowances. Applicants are required to produce specific certificates as per eligibility conditions.
21. The service conditions including probation period and superannuation shall be governed as per UGC /Government of India norms.
22. Candidates applying for the post of Professors and Associate Professors must fill-in and attach “Methodology for University and College Teachers for calculating Academic / Research Score” (As per Appendix II, Table-2 of UGC Regulations, 2018) along with the printout of Online Application form, failing which the applications will be summarily rejected. The claimed Research score must be supported by documentary evidences otherwise such claim would not be entertained.
23. Candidates applying for the post of Assistant Professor must fill in Table-3A (as per Appendix II of UGC Regulations, 2018) and attach along with the printout of Online Application form.
24. Research publications only from the journals indexed in UGC-CARE List/ Scopus/ Web of Science will be considered for calculation of the API score.
25. While applying online, the candidates must provide evidences of their published works in accordance with the UGC regulations 2018 and subsequent amendments, if any.
26. Candidates applying for the post of Professor and Associate Professor shall necessarily submit self-attested printed copies of top Ten & top Seven full length research papers respectively along



with hard copies of the application.

27. Applicants who have been awarded UG/ PG/ Ph.D. from foreign Universities should enclose "Equivalence Certificate" issued by Association of Indian Universities, New Delhi, without which their candidature will not be considered and application will summarily be rejected.
28. The applications received for the posts of Assistant Professor, Associate Professor and Professor shall be screened in compliance with the screening guidelines laid down in the UGC Regulations on Minimum Qualifications for Appointment of Teachers and other Academic Staff in Universities and Colleges and Measures for the Maintenance of Standards in Higher Education, 2018, as amended from time to time or AICTE / NCTE/ ICAR norms as applicable.
29. Incomplete applications in any respect shall be summarily rejected.
30. The eligibility of the candidate will be determined on the last date of submission of online application as mentioned in the advertisement published by the university.
31. Merely fulfilling the minimum qualifications or the eligibility criteria does not entitle an applicant to be necessarily considered or called for interview. The University may restrict the number of applicants to be called for interview on the recommendations of the short screening committee.
32. Selection will be made on the basis of candidates' overall record and performance in the interview. The University may assess the ability of teaching and / or research aptitude through a seminar or lecture in a classroom situation or discussion on the capacity to use the latest technology in teaching and research at the interview stage.
33. All original documents should be produced for verification at the time of interview if called for.
34. No TA/DA shall be paid to applicants for attending interview.
35. In case of any inadvertent mistake in the process of selection, which may be detected at any stage even after issuing an appointment letter, the University reserves the right to modify/ withdraw/ cancel any communication made to the applicant in this regard.
36. All appointments shall be made provisionally subject to verification of certificates. The University shall verify the documents and antecedents of the applicant at the time of interview/joining or at any stage during the period of service. In case, it is found at any point of time that any document/information submitted by the applicant is false or the applicant has suppressed any relevant information, the services of the selected applicant shall be terminated forthwith without assigning any reason.
