About the Workshop

Moreover, this program will facilitate the establishment of a vibrant academic community, fostering collaboration and elevating the overall research quality in the social sciences domain.

Course Objectives and Methodology

This programme is designed to enhanced the research skills of the young faculty members and equip them with the knowledge and tools necessary for producing high – quality publication for Young Teacher of Social Science in the discipline like Political Science, Economic, History, Sociology, Anthropology, Tribal Studies, Social Works, and National Security Studies of the university and faculty from colleges.

Key Components of the Program Included:

1. **Research Proposal Formulation:** Crafting a robust research proposal is essential for defining the scope and objectives of a study. This element focuses on training participants to articulate clear research questions, outline comprehensive methodologies, and set achievable goals. Effective proposal formulation ensures a strong foundation for any research project.
2. **Ethics in Social Science Research:** Ethical considerations are paramount in social science research. This element emphasizes the importance of maintaining integrity, respecting participants' rights, and avoiding misconduct such as plagiarism. Training in research ethics ensures that studies are conducted responsibly and ethically, upholding the trust and validity of the research community.
3. **Effective Research Paper Writing:** Writing a compelling and well-structured research paper is crucial for disseminating findings and contributing to academic discourse. This element provides guidance on the organization of research papers, development of compelling abstracts, and adherence to proper reference formats. It aims to enhance the clarity and impact of academic writing.
4. **Use of Statistics and ICT in Social Science Research:** The application of statistical tools and Information and Communication Technology (ICT) is vital for analysing and managing data in social science research. This element focuses on training participants to utilize statistical software and ICT resources effectively, thereby improving the accuracy and efficiency of their research processes.
5. **Social Impact and Policy Influence of Research:** Research in social sciences has the potential to influence policy and create social change. This element highlights the importance of understanding and communicating the broader social implications of research findings. It also explores strategies for engaging with policymakers and stakeholders to ensure that research contributes to informed decision-making and societal progress.

About the University

Rajiv Gandhi University (formerly Arunachal University) is the premier institution for higher education in the state of Arunachal Pradesh and has completed twenty-five years of its existence. Late Smt. Indira Gandhi, the then Prime Minister of India, laid the foundation stone of the university on 4th February 1984 at Rono Hills, where the present campus is located. Ever since its inception, the university has been trying to achieve excellence and fulfill the objectives as envisaged in the University Act. The University got academic recognition under section 2(f) from the University Grants Commission on 28th March, 1985 and started functioning from 1st April, 1985.
