

	<p>(ix) Introduction of the two Faculties – (i) Faculty of Medical Sciences and (ii) Faculty of Medical Health and Paramedical Sciences at RGU.</p> <p>The AC noted the proposal and resolved that the university will constitute a committee to review the nomenclature as per the National Medical Commission (NMC) guidelines and compare it with other health institutes. The report of the committee will be presented at the next AC Meeting for deliberation and decision.</p> <p>(x) Appointment of Dean to liaise with the TRIHMS, Naharlagun</p> <p>The AC noted and approved the proposal to appoint a Dean to liaise with TRIHMS, Naharlagun. The university and TRIHMS will develop a modus operandi for this liaison.</p> <p>(xi) Appointment of an Officer at the rank of Assistant Registrar (AR) to look after the matters related to RGU and TRIHMS, Naharlagun</p> <p>The AC noted the need for a dedicated Officer to oversee the matters pertaining to Rajiv Gandhi University (RGU) and Tomo Riba Institute of Health and Medical Sciences (TRIHMS), Naharlagun. To facilitate this, the TRIHMS, Naharlagun is required to submit a formal proposal to the university outlining the necessity and scope of the appointment.</p> <p>Once the request letter is received from TRIHMS, Naharlagun, the university will take administrative steps to appoint an Officer. The modus operandi for this appointment will be determined in accordance with the needs and operational requirements of both institutions.</p> <p>(xii) Visit of university inspection team to all Permanent Affiliated Colleges</p> <p>AC noted that as per the university ordinance published in the Gazette of India, there is a provision to send an inspection team in every three years to all the permanent affiliated colleges to inspect and oversee their academic activities. After thorough discussion, the AC approved the proposal. The Academic Branch will initiate the matter immediately.</p>
