1. That this Higher Educational Institution namely Rajiv Gandhi University is recognized/entitled to offer Open and Distance Learning Programmes and /or Online Programmes (as applicable) under University Grants Commission (Open and Distance Learning Programmes and Online Programmes) Regulations, 2020 and its subsequent amendments.
2. That the deponents have fully understood all clauses, terms and conditions as stipulated in the University Grants Commission (Open and Distance Learning Programmes and Online Programmes) Regulations, 2020 (including its amendments from time to time).
3. That the Higher Educational Institution shall scrupulously abide by all the terms and conditions as stipulated under University Grants Commission (Open and Distance Learning Programmes and Online Programmes) Regulations, 2020 and its amendments along with the provisions mentioned in its Annexures.
4. That the Higher Educational Institution offering above mentioned Undergraduate, Postgraduate and Postgraduate diploma programmes under the discipline of Management, Computer Applications and Travel and Tourism from academic year 2024-25, academic session beginning September, 2024 (revised from July-August, 2024) and onwards is adhering to the following:

- a. The entry level qualifications, curriculum, teaching-learning scheme, pattern of question papers (for end semester examination or term end examination), pass or fail criteria followed by HEI are same as for conventional programme and Open and Distance Learning programme, as applicable.
 - b. Availability of good quality Self-Learning Material/E- Learning Material and regular updating of Learning Material from the perspective of improving quality and learner support.
 - c. Appointment of requisite number of full time dedicated faculty exclusively for above mentioned ODL/ online programmes as stipulated under Annexure-IV of UGC (Open and Distance Learning Programmes and Online Programmes) Regulations, 2020 (including its amendments from time to time).
 - d. Arrangement of regular assignments to enrolled candidates and their evaluation/feedback.
 - e. The examination system shall be proctored to ensure transparency and security.
 - f. Model curriculum framework/model curriculum and credit framework as defined by AICTE.
 - g. Ensure the delivery of Self-Learning material to learners for ODL programmes within a fortnight from the date of admission (for ODL programmes).

1. That this Higher Educational Institution namely Rajiv Gandhi University wishes to apply for the recognition of Open and Distance Learning Programmes and /or Online Programmes (**as applicable**) to be offered under University Grants Commission (Open and Distance Learning Programmes and Online Programmes) Regulations, 2020 and its amendments from the **academic year 2024-25, academic session beginning September, 2024 (revised from July-August, 2024) and onwards.**
2. That the deponents have fully understood all clauses, all terms and conditions as stipulated in the University Grants Commission (Open and Distance Learning Programmes and Online Programmes) Regulations, 2020 (including its amendments from time to time).
3. That the Higher Educational Institution is eligible in all respect to apply for offering programmes through Open and Distance Learning (ODL) mode, as per University Grants Commission (Open and Distance Learning Programmes and Online Programmes) Regulations, 2020 and its amendments.

In the event, the applicable statutory or regulatory authority or regulatory council permits such programme(s), the HEI shall submit the approval or recommendation of the said authority or council, for consideration of the Commission.
 7. That the Higher Education Institution shall ensure compliance to other relevant UGC Regulations and norms issued by the relevant statutory/regulatory bodies from time to time.
 8. That for the programmes falling under the ambit of a statutory or regulatory authority or regulatory council, the Higher Educational Institution has the approval or recommendations of the respective statutory or regulatory authority or regulatory council for offering the programmes in Open and Distance Learning mode or Online mode, as applicable; and has also submitted the same to UGC along with the application.
