PRESENTATION

- For poster presentation, the size of the poster will be 80 cm (B) x 100 cm (L), briefly showing title, Author's Name & Address, Introduction with Objective, Methodology, Results and Discussion (Tables, Figures and Photographs), bulleted Summary or Conclusion.
- The poster shall be attractive with appropriate colour scheme so that the content is readable from a distance of at least one meter.
