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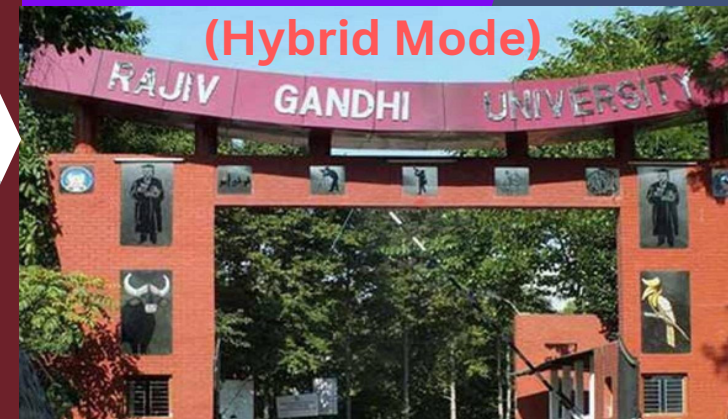

Rajiv Gandhi University (formerly Arunachal University) is the premier institution for higher education in the state of Arunachal Pradesh and has completed twenty five years of its existence. Late Smt. Indira Gandhi, the then Prime Minister of India, laid the foundation stone of the university on 4th February 1984 at Rono Hills, where the present campus is located. Ever since its inception, the university has been trying to achieve excellence and fulfil the objectives as envisaged in the University Act. The University got academic recognition under section 2(f) from the University Grants Commission on 28th March, 1985 and started functioning from 1st April, 1985. It got financial recognition under section 12-B of the UGC on 25th March, 1994. Since then Rajiv Gandhi University then Arunachal University has carved a niche for itself in the educational scenario of the country following its selection as a University with potential for excellence by a high level expert committee of University Grants Commission from among universities in India. The University was converted into a Central University with effect from 9th April 2007 as per notification of Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India. Recently it has been accredited by NAAC as 'A' Grade.

About the Department

The Department of Education was established in 1988 and started B. Ed. programme in the academic session 1988-89. The Department was set up with the objective of producing the faculty for teaching at college and University level. At present, the Department is running Two year B.Ed programme (100 student), M.A. (Education) 62 students and ITEP B. A. B. Ed. Secondary stage (50 students) aligned with NEP 2020. The Department also possesses research facility for Ph.D. research scholars. Presently 19 faculty members are working in the department and engaged in major and minor research projects of various agencies like UGC, ICSSR and SSA, Arunachal Pradesh

- APA 7th edition of reference Style should be followed for writing Reference and Citations.
- The paper should mention name(s) of author(s), email and contact Number.
